ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR  
LIMITED EXPEDITED DISCOVERY

This matter is before the Court for consideration of plaintiff’s motion for limited expedited discovery and a letter rogatory. Dkt. # 82. Plaintiff seeks to obtain “original and complete copies of unsigned reports of fiber analysis” that were submitted by defendant Knitting Fever, Inc., (“KFI”) in opposition to plaintiff’s motion for a preliminary injunction. Pursuant to F.R.Civ.Proc. 26(d)(1), plaintiff must obtain leave of Court to conduct discovery at this stage of the proceedings. Defendant has objected that plaintiff has not demonstrated good cause for discovery while motions to dismiss are still pending. Dkt. # 100. However, defendant KFI has not filed a motion to dismiss for lack of jurisdiction, and the motion to dismiss the RICO claim

1 does not implicate matters at issue in this motion. The Court finds that plaintiff has  
2 demonstrated good cause for the limited discovery proposed.

3 Accordingly, plaintiff's motion for limited expedited discovery is GRANTED. The  
4 Court on this date will sign the Letter of Request for International Assistance presented by  
5 plaintiff.
