



**Pastaza Hats (A101)
Using Cascade Pastaza Pattern**



Pastaza Hats (A101)

Hat Size: 18", 20", 22", 24"

Materials Used: Cascade Pastaza - 100g

MC - Main Colour: 1

CC1 - Contrast 1: 1

CC2 - Contrast 2: 1

CC3 - Contrast 3: 1

US - 8 (5.00mm) 16" (40cm) circular needle & DPN.

TENSION:

18 sts to 4" (10 cm) over st-st on US - 8 (5.00 mm) needles or size required to give correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS:

beg beginning	cont continue
K Knit	P purl
rds rounds	rep repeat
st(s) stitch(es)	Sl slip
st-st stocking stitch	wyib with yarn in back
wyif with yarn in front	

SPECIAL NOTE: EXCEPT when working decreases on earflaps, all slipped stitches are slipped purlwise.

DIAMOND DESIGN

With US - 8 (5.00 mm) needle, using **C1** & **C3** with two-colour cast on method, (see instructions on last page) cast on 80 (90 - 100 - 110) sts.

****Next round:** With **C3**, taking care not to twist stitches, join round, placing a marker on needle to mark beg of round. Purl to end of round.

Next round: With **C1**, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C1**, (wyib, Sl1. wyif, P1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C3**, knit.**

Next round: With **C3**, purl.

Cont in st-st (knit every round), work from graph A.

***18" size only:

With **C1**, (K6, K2tog) to end of round. (70sts)

Next round: With **C3**, knit.

Next round: With **C3**, purl.

Next round: With **C1**, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C1**, (wyib, Sl1. wyif, P1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C3**, knit.

Next round: With **C3**, purl.

Next round: With **C3**, (K5, K2tog) to end of round. (60sts)

Next round: (K1 **C3**, K1 **MC**) to end of round.

Next 3 rounds: With **MC**, knit.

Next round: With **C3**, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C3**, (wyib, Sl1. wyif, P1) to end of round.

Next 2 rounds: With **MC**, knit.

Next round: With **C3**, (K1, Sl1) to end of round.

20" size only:

With **C1**, (K7, K2tog) to end of round. (80sts)

Work next 2 rounds from graph B.

Next round: With **C3**, knit.

Next round: With **C3**, (P6, P2tog) to end of round. (70sts)

Next round: With **C1**, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C1**, (wyib, Sl1. wyif, P1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C3**, knit.

Next round: With **C3**, purl.

Next round: With **C3**, knit.

Next 2 rounds: (K1 **C3**, K1 **MC**) to end of round.

Next 2 rounds: With **MC**, knit.

22" size only:

With **C1**, (K8, K2tog) to end of round. (90sts)

Work next 2 rounds from graph B.

Next round: With **C3**, knit.

Next round: With **C3**, (P7, P2tog) to end of round. (80sts)

Next round: With **C1**, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C1**, (wyib, Sl1. wyif, P1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C3**, knit.

Next round: With **C3**, purl.

Next round: With **C3**, (K6, K2tog) to end of round. (70sts)

Next 2 rounds: (K1 **C3**, K1 **MC**) to end of round.

Next 3 rounds: With **MC**, knit.

Next round: With **MC**, (K5, K2tog) to end of round.(60sts)

Next round: With **C3**, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With **C3**, (wyib, Sl1. wyif, P1) to end of round.

Next 2 rounds: With **MC**, knit.

24" size only:

With **C1**, (K9, K2tog) to end of round. (100sts)

Work next 2 rounds from graph B.

Next round: With **C3**, knit.

Next round: With **C3**, (P8, P2tog) to end of round. (90sts)

Next round: With **C1**, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With C1, (wyib, Sl1. wyif, P1) to end of round.
Next round: With C3, knit.
Next round: With C3, purl.
Next round: With C3, (K7, K2tog) to end of round. (80sts)
Next 2 rounds: (K1 C3, K1 MC) to end of round.
Next 3 rounds: With MC, knit.
Next round: With MC, (K6, K2tog) to end of round.(70sts)
Next round: With MC, knit.
Next round: With C3, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.
Next round: With C3, (wyib, Sl1. wyif, P1) to end of round.
Next 2 rounds: With MC, knit.
Next round: With C3, (K1, Sl1) to end of round.
Next round: With C3, (wyif, P1. wyib Sl1) to end of round.

All Sizes:

Next round: With MC, (K4, K2tog) to end of round.(50sts)

Work next 4 rounds from graph D.

Next round: With C3, knit.
Next round: With C3, (K3, K2tog) to end of round. (40sts)

18" & 20" sizes only:

Next 2 rounds: With C3, knit.

22" & 24" sizes only:

Next 3 rounds: With C3, knit.

All sizes:

Next round: With C3, (K2, K2tog) to end of round. (30sts)
Next round: With MC, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.
Next round: With MC, (wyib, Sl1. wyif, P1) to end of round.
Next round: With C3, knit.
Next round: With C3, (K1, K2tog) to end of round. (20sts)
Next round: (K1 C3, K1 MC) to end of round.

18" & 20" sizes only:

Next round: With MC, knit.

22" & 24" sizes only:

Next 2 rounds: With MC, knit.

All sizes:

Next round: With MC, (K2tog) to end of round. (10sts)
Next 2 rounds: With MC, knit.
Next round: With MC, (K2tog) to end of round. (5sts)

Break off yarn and thread through remaining stitches and fasten off.

EARFLAPS

With US - 8 (5.00 mm) DPN, using C3. Start approximately 11 (12 - 12 - 13) sts along from centre back, pick up 12 (14 - 16 - 16) sts on 1st needle. Turn work and pick up 6 (7 - 8 - 8) sts on 2nd needle. (pick up these stitches in the same loops that the first set of stitches was picked up from - this is a little tricky but the end result is worth it!) Pick up a further 6 (7 - 8 - 8) sts on 3rd needle in the same way.

Work 10 (10 - 12 - 12) rds in st-st (knit every round - the first couple of rounds will be a little tricky)

Next round: Sl1, K1, pssso. K to last 2sts on 1st needle, K2tog. Sl1, K1, pssso. K to end of 2nd needle. K to last 2sts on 3rd needle, K2tog.

Rep last round until 4sts remain. Break off yarn, thread through remaining sts and pull up tight. Fasten off.***

SNOWFLAKE DESIGN

With US - 8 (5.00 mm) needle, using C1 & C3 with two-colour cast on method, cast on 84 (90 - 104 - 108) sts.

Work as for Diamond hat from ** to **.

Next round: With C3, purl, inc 0 (1 - 0 - 0) st at centre of round. (84 - 91 - 104 - 108sts)

Cont in st-st (knit every round), work from graph C.

18", 20" & 22" sizes only:

Next round: With MC, knit, dec 4 (1 - 4)sts evenly around round. (80 - 90 - 100sts)

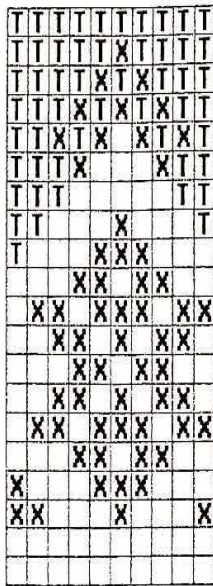
24" size only:

Next round: With MC, knit, inc 2sts evenly around round. (110sts)

All sizes:

Work next 3 rounds from graph D.

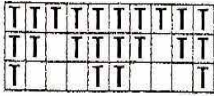
Work as for Snowflake hat from *** to***.

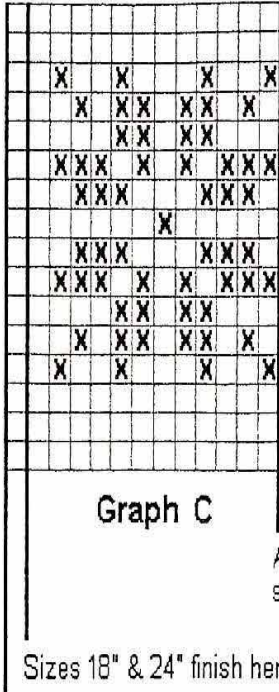

Graph C

All sizes start here

Sizes 18" & 24" finish here (12st rep)

Sizes 20" & 22" finish here (13st rep)

NOTE:

Read all rows from right to left.

TWO-COLOUR CAST ON

Leaving tails about 8" [20cm] long, tie the two yarns together in a knot (to be undone later). With your right hand, hold the knot on top of the needle a short distance from the tip, then place one yarn over your index finger and the other over your thumb. Continue as for a long-tail cast on. Bring the needle up through the loop on your thumb, hook it around the yarn on your finger, and back through the loop on your thumb. The yarn held on your index finger will make the stitches on the needle, the yarn on your thumb will make the horizontal ridge at the base of the cast on row.
