Pastaza Hats

Hat Sizes: 18", 20", 22", 24"

Materials: Pastaza –50% Llama / 50% Wool– 100g/ 132 yards

Rust Colorway- #070, #050 , #002 and #316

Blue Colorway-#006, #032, #031 and #6002

Pink Colorway- #311, #306, #278 and #275

Mark your MC and CC here:

MC CC1 CC2 CC3

Needle Size: US 8 (5 mm) / 16" (40 cm) Circular Needle and DPN

Gauge: 18 sts to 4" (10 cm) over st-st on US 8 (5 mm) needles or size required to give correct gauge.

Abbreviations:

Beg– beginning

K– knit

Rds– rounds

St(s)- stitch(es)

St-st– stocking stitch

Wyif– with yarn in front

Cont– continue

P– purl

Rep– repeat

Sl-slip

Pssso-pass slipped stitch over

Wyib-with yarn in back

Special Note: Except when working decreases on earflaps, all slipped stitches are slipped purl-wise.

Diamond Design:

With US 8 (5 mm) needle, using CC1 and CC3 with two-colour cast on method, (see instructions on last page) cast on 80 (90, 100, 110) sts.

****Next round:** With CC3, taking care not to twist stitches, join round, placing a marker on needle to mark beg of round. Purl to end of round.

Next round: With CC1, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With CC1, (wyib, Sl1, wyif, P1) to end of round.

Next round: With CC3, knit.**

Next round: With CC3, purl.

Cont. in st-st (knit every round), work form graph A.

***18" size only:**

With CC1, (K6, K2Tog) to end of round. (70 sts)

Next round: With CC3, knit.

Next round: With CC3, purl.

Next round: With CC1, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With CC1, (wyib, Sl1, wyif, P1) to end of round.

Next round: With CC3, knit.

Next round: With CC3, purl.

Next round With CC3, (K5, K2Tog) to end of round. (60 sts)

Next round: (K1, C3, K1 MC) to end of round.

Next 3 rounds: With MC, knit.

Next round: With CC3, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With CC1, (wyib, Sl1, wyif, P1) to end of round.

18" and 20" Sizes Only:

Next 2 rounds: With CC3, knit.

22" and 24" Sizes Only:

Next 3 rounds: With CC3, knit.

All Sizes:

Next round: With CC3, (K2, K2Tog) to end of round. (30 sts)

Next round: With MC, (Sl1, K1) to end of round.

Next round: With MC, (wyib, Sl1, wyif, P1) to end of round.

Next round: With CC3, knit.

Next round: With CC3, (K1, K2Tog) to end of round. (20 sts)

Next round: (K1 CC3, K1 MC) to end of round.

18" and 20" Sizes Only:

Next round: With MC, knit.

22" and 24" Sizes Only:

Next 2 rounds: With MC, knit.

All Sizes:

Next round: With MC, (K2Tog) to end of round. (10sts)

Next 2 rounds: With MC, knit.

Next round: With MC, (K2Tog) to end of round. (5 sts)

Break off yarn and thread through remaining stitches and fasten off.

Earflaps

With US 8 (5 mm) DPN, using CC3, Start approximately 11 (12, 12, 13) sts along from centre back, pick up 12(14,16,16) sts on 1st needle. Turn work and pick up 6(7,8,8) sts on 2nd needle. (Pick up these stitches in the same loops that the first set of stitches were picked up from—this is a little tricky but the end result is worth it!) Pick up a further 6(7,8,8) sts on 3rd needle in the same way.

Work 10(10,12,12) rounds in st-st (knit every round—the first couple of rounds will be a little tricky)

Next round: Sl1, K1 pssso. K to last 2 sts on 1st needle, K2Tog, Sl1, K1 pssso, K to end of 2nd needle. K to last 2 sts on 3rd needle, K2Tog.

Rep last round until 4 sts remain. Break off yarn, thread through remaining sts and pull up tight. Fasten off**

Snowflake Design:

With US 8 (5 mm) needle, using CC1 & CC3 with two-colour cast on method, cast on 84 (90,104,108) sts.

Work as for Diamond Hat from **to**.

Next round: With CC3, purl, inc 0(1,0,0) st at centre of round. 84(91,104,108)sts.
Cont in st-st, work from graph C.

18", 20" and 22" Sizes Only:

Next round: With MC, knit, dec 4 (,4) sts evenly around. (80,90,100) sts.

24" Size Only:

Next round: With MC, knit, inc 2 sts evenly around (110 sts)

All Sizes:

Work next 3 rounds from graph D.

Work as for Snowflake hat from **to**,

***Finishing Pastaza Hats**

For the top Break off yarn leaving an 8" tail, thread thru remaining stitches leaving tail on the outside. Cut 6 24" lengths of yarn. Using base of tail wrap around center of the strands several times and then anchor firmly in place. Fold strands in half, you now have 12 strands. Divide into three and braid firmly until about 1" from the end. Knot and trim.

For Earflaps Cut 6 36" lengths of yarn. Fold in half and with a crochet hook pull the 6 strands thru the tip of the earflap as if attaching fringe. You now have 12 strands. Divide into 3 and braid firmly until about 1" from the end. Knot and trim. Repeat for 2nd earflap.

Weaving in ends and block.

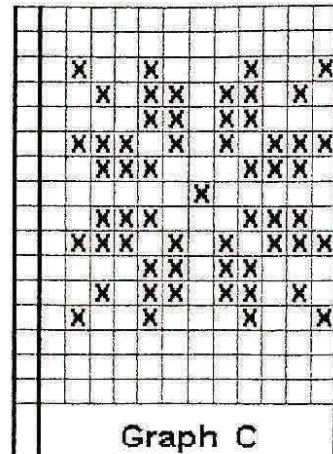

All sizes start here

Sizes 18" & 24" finish here (12st rep)

Sizes 20" & 22" finish here (13st rep)

TWO-COLOUR CAST ON

Leaving tails about 8" [20cm] long, tie the two yarns together in a knot (to be undone later). With your right hand, hold the knot on top of the needle a short distance from the tip, then place one yarn over your index finger and the other over your thumb. Continue as for a long-tail cast on. Bring the needle up through the loop on your thumb, hook it around the yarn on your finger, and back through the loop on your thumb. The yarn held on your index finger will make the stitches on the needle, the yarn on your thumb will make the horizontal ridge at the base of the cast on row.
