FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

	Small	Medium	Large
Length	24"	24"	29"
Width	44"	52"	60"
Sleeve length	17"	17"	17"
Skeins	15	16	18

GAUGE: 22sts = 4" and 23"rows = 4" in pattern using larger size needles

NEEDLES: US 7 & 9

MATERIAL: Cascade Pastaza, 50% llama & 50% wool, 100g, 132 yds; 5-7 buttons

STITCH DESCRIPTION:

T6R rib (Twist 6 Right rib) = slip next 4sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2sts from left-hand needle, slip the 2 purl sts from cable needle back to left-hand needle and purl them, then knit 2sts from cable needle.

T6L rib (Twist 6 Left rib) = slip next 4sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, knit next 2sts from left-hand needle, slip the 2 purl sts from cable needle back to left-hand needle and purl them, then knit 2sts from cable needle.

CABLE: Multiple of 12sts + 2

Row 1 (right side): P2, *k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 2 and every alt row: K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end

Row 3 : P2, *T6R rib, p2, k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 5 & 7 : Repeat row 1.

Row 9 : P2, *k2, p2, T6L rib, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 11 : Repeat row 1.

Row 12 : Repeat row 2.

Rep these 12 rows for cable pattern

BACK:

Using smaller needle cast on 102(126,150)sts and P2, K2 rib for 2" increasing 20sts evenly spaced in last row (122,146,170sts). Change to larger needle and begin pattern. Continue for 23½(23½",28½)". Begin neck decreases by working 43(55,67)sts in pattern, cast off center 36, and work remaining 43(55,67)sts in pattern. Continue working on the remaining 43(55,67)sts until piece measures 24(24,29)" in total. Bind off all sts. Rejoin yarn to the first 43(55,67)sts and work in pattern until piece measure 24(24,29)". Bind off remaining sts.

RIGHT FRONT:

With smaller needle cast on 52(64,76)sts and work p2, k2 rib for 2" increasing 10sts evenly across last row (62,74,86sts). Change to larger needle and begin pattern. Work for 20(20,25)" and begin neckline decreases.

RIGHT NECKLINE DECREASE:

With right side facing, continue in pattern and cast off 12sts at beginning of next row. Then at neck edge decrease 2sts every other row 3x and 1 st every row 4x(40,52,64)sts. Continue in pattern until piece measures same as back. Bind off all sts.

LEFT FRONT:

With smaller needle cast on 52(64,76)sts and work p2, k2 rib for 2" increasing 10sts evenly across last row (62,74,86sts). Change to larger needle and begin pattern. Work for 20(20,25)" and begin neckline decreases.

With wrong side facing, continue in pattern and cast off 12sts at beginning of next row. Then at neck edge decrease 2sts every other row 3x and 1 st every row 4x(40,52,64)sts. Continue in pattern until piece measures same as back. Bind off all sts.

SLEEVES: (Make 2)

With smaller needle cast on 54sts and p2, k2 rib for 1" increasing 12sts evenly across last row(66sts). Change to larger size needle and begin pattern. Increase 1 st each end of row every 4th row. When 110sts on needle continue pattern until 17" in length. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING TOUCHES:

Block pieces. Attach shoulder seams, sew sleeves to body and sew side seams.

COLLAR:

With smaller needle, pick up 86sts along collar edge. K2, p2 rib for 2". Bind off all sts.

BUTTONBANDS:

With smaller needle, pick up 106(106,126)sts along right front and collar. K2, p2 rib for 2" inserting 5-7 buttonholes evenly spaced at 4th row. Bind off all sts. With smaller needle, pick up 106(106,126)sts along left front and collar. K2, p2 rib for 2". Bind off all sts.

ABBREVIATIONS:

St/Sts = stitch(es)

K = knit

P = purl
