Sizes

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X). Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for other sizes noted in parentheses as necessary.

Finished Measurements

Bust: 35 ½ (37 ½, 40 ½, 43 ½, 46 ½, 49 ½)"

Total length: 24 (24 ½, 24 ½, 25, 25 ½, 25 ½)"

Materials

- Cascade Yarn's *SoftSpun*, 2 (3, 4, 4, 5, 6) hanks of #2825 (A), 1 hank of #2808 (B), and 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6) hanks of #2824 (C)
- One pair *each* of sizes 8 and 9 knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- Two stitch markers

Gauge

In Stockinette St Patt with larger needles, 16 sts and 24 rows = 4". **To save time, take time to check gauge.**

Stitch Patterns

Rib Pattern (*mult 2 sts*)

Row 1 (RS): *K1, P1. Repeat from * across.

Patt Row: As Row 1.

Repeat Patt Row.

Stockinette St Pattern

Row 1 (RS): Knit across.

Row 2: Purl across.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for patt.

Snowflake Pattern (*mult 16 + 13 sts*)

See chart.

Back

With smaller needles and B, CO 68 (74, 80, 86, 92, 98) sts.

Beg Rib Patt, and work one row.

Change to A, and cont even in Rib Patt until piece measures approx 3" from beg, ending after WS row, inc 1 st at beg of last row—69 (75, 81, 87, 93, 99) sts.

Change to larger needles, beg Stockinette St Patt, and work even until piece measures approx 10 ¼ (10 ¾, 10 ¾, 11 ¼, 11 ¾, 11 ¾)" from beg, ending after WS row.

Place Patts

Next Row (RS): Work 4 (7, 2, 5, 8, 11) sts in Stockinette St with A, place marker, work Row 1 of Snowflake chart over middle 61 (61, 77, 77, 77, 77) sts, place marker, work Stockinette St with A across to end row.

Cont patts as established until Row 20 of chart is completed.

Cont even in Stockinette St Patt with C until piece measures approx 15 ½" from beg, ending after WS row.

Shape Armholes

BO 3 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9) sts at beg of next two rows, BO 2 (2, 3, 3, 4, 4) sts at beg of next two rows, then dec 1 st each side every row 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 2) times, then every other row 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 5) times—51 (53, 55, 57, 59, 59) sts rem.

Cont even in patt until piece measures approx 23 (23 ½, 23 ½, 24, 24 ½, 24 ½)" from beg, ending after WS row.

Shape Shoulders

BO 4 (4, 5, 5, 5, 5) at beg of next four rows, then BO 4 (5, 4, 5, 6, 6) sts at beg of next two rows.

BO rem 27 sts.

Front

Work same as back until piece measures approx 21 (21 ½, 21 ½, 22, 22 ½, 22 ½)" from beg, ending after WS row.

Shape Neck

Work across first 19 (20, 21, 22, 23, 23) sts, join second ball of yarn and BO middle 13 sts, work across to end row.

Work both sides at once with separate balls of yarn, and BO 3 sts each neck edge once, BO 2 sts each neck edge once, then dec 1 st each neck edge twice—12 (13, 14, 15, 16, 16) sts rem each side.

Complete same as back.

Sleeves

With smaller needles and B, CO 36 sts.

Beg Rib Patt, and work one row.

Change to C, and cont even in Rib Patt until piece measures approx 2 ½" from beg, ending after WS row, inc 1 st at beg of last row—37 sts.

Change to larger needles, beg Stockinette St Patt, and inc 1 st each side every tenth row 0 (0, 0, 2, 8, 8) times, every twelfth row 0 (3, 3, 6, 1, 1) times, every fourteenth row 2 (4, 4, 0, 0, 0) times, then every sixteenth row 4 (0, 0, 0, 0, 0) times—49 (51, 51, 53, 55, 55) sts.

Cont even until sleeve measures approx 18 ½" from beg, ending after WS row.

Shape Cap

BO 3 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9) sts at beg of next two rows, then dec 1 st each side every sixth row 0 (0, 0, 1, 3, 5) times, every fourth row 4 (7, 8, 7, 5, 2) times, then every other row 6 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0) times—23 sts rem.

Work 1 (0, 0, 1, 0, 0) row even.

BO 3 sts at the beg of next four rows—11 sts rem.

BO.

Finishing

Block pieces to measurements.

Sew left shoulder seam.

Neckband

With RS facing, smaller needles, and C, pick up and knit 74 sts evenly along neckline.

Beg Rib Patt, and work even until neckband measures approx 3 ½" from beg.

Change to B, work one row of Rib Patt.

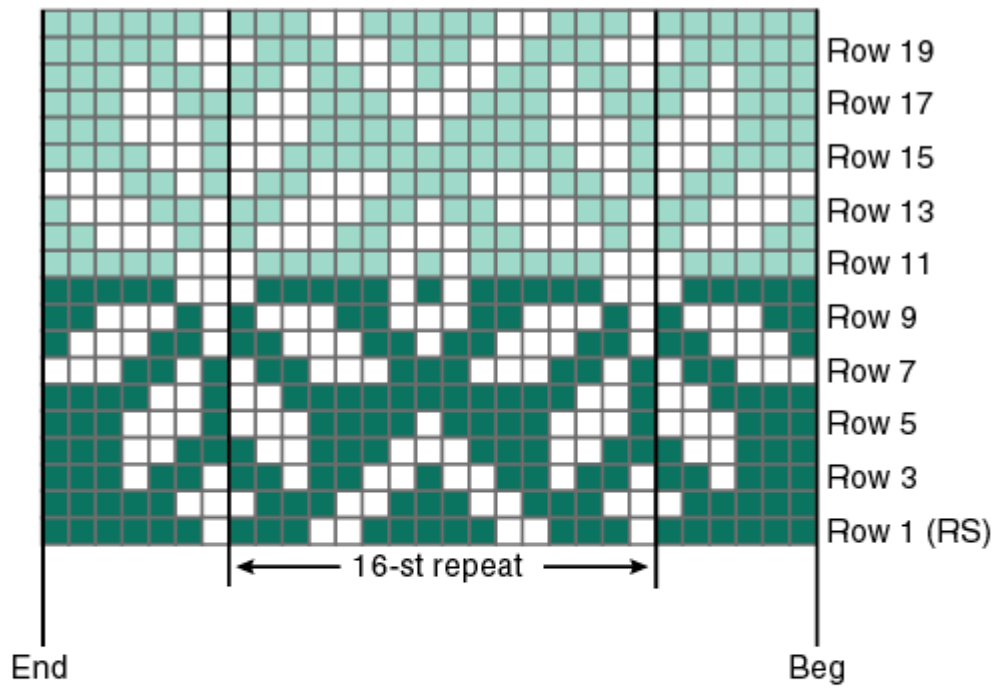
BO in patt.

Sew right shoulder seam, including side of neckband.

Set in sleeves.

Sew sleeve and side seams.
