## Cascade Lana Bambu Shawl

# LANA BAMBU SHAWL

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MATERIALS: Cascade Yarns Lana Bambu Paints: 3 skeins  
Size 9 long circular needles  
Stitch markers  
Yarn Needle

## Hourglass Eyelet Pattern (mult. 6 + 1)

Row 1: (right side) K6, \*P1, K5; rep from \* , end K1.

Row 2: K1, \*P5, K1; rep from \* across.

Row 3: K1, \*YO, ssk, P1, K2 tog, YO, K1; rep from \* across.

Row 4: K1, P2, \*K1, P5; rep from \* to last 4 sts, end K1, P2, K1.

Row 5: K3, \*P1, K5; rep from \* to end last repeat K3.

Row 6: K1, P2, \*K1, P5; rep from \* to last 4 sts, end K1, P2, K1.

Row 7: K1, \*K2 tog, YO, K1, YO, ssk, P1; rep from \* , end last rep K1 instead of P1.

Row 8: K1, \*P5, K1; rep from \*

Repeat rows 1-8 for pattern.

Cast on 13 sts.

Work row one of pattern.

On row 2 and all even rows, inc 1 st at the beg and end of row. Use stitch markers to separate increased stitches from pattern stitches, working in garter stitch until there are 6 new stitches, then work into pattern.

Work 23 repeats (rows 1-8), then 6 rows of garter stitch. Bind off loosely. Weave in all ends.

Make two tassels for front points with remaining yarn if desired.

Roll center back for collar about 2" and let drape around.
