# Cloud 9 Just for Fun Wristers

Aka: Stacy's Stripes

**Materials:** Cascade Yarns Cloud 9: 50% Wool, 50% Angora: 1 skein each, color A #149 dk brown, color B #134 reddish brown, color C # 135 beige, Color D #186 dk rose. NOTE: if you are also making the scarf to match, you will only need one more ball of color A. There is enough of the other colors for both projects.  
Size 9 needles, double pointed, set of 5.  
Stitch markers  
Yarn needle  
About 1 yd contrasting waste yarn

**Size:** 8" wide by 9 ½" long

**Gauge:** 4 sts = 1", 6 rows = 1" in Stockinette stitch (st st)

PM= place marker

Yf = bring yarn to the front of work

Yb= bring yarn back to the back of work.

RS = right side facing

Sl = slip stitch to right needle purlwise

## WRISTERS

With color A, cast on 32 sts. Join, being careful not to twist stitches. With 8 sts on each of 4 needles, work in K1, P1 ribbing for 6 rows. Inc 1 st on last row (33 sts)

Work in st st for 4 rows. (knit every row in the round) Change to color B.

Interchange Rows:

Row 1: With new color, \*K1, yf, sl 1, yb; rep from \* around, end K1.

Row 2: \*yf, sl 1, yb, K1; rep from \* around, end yf, sl 1, yb.

Work 3 rows in st st.

Work the following color sequence, working the number of rows indicated after the color indicated  
in st st after

the Interchange Rows have been completed with the new color..

Color A: 1 row

Color C: 5 rows

Color A: 1 row

Color D: 3 rows

Color A: 1 row

Color B: 5 rows

Color A: 1 THUMB PREPARATION ROW

After the 2 interchange rows have been worked in color A, K 6 sts on waste yarn and slip back onto  
the left

hand needle. Knit them again using the working yarn and complete the row.

Continue the color changes as follows in same manner as before.

Color C: 3 rows

Color A: 1 row

Color D: 2 rows.

Now work Interchange Rows in color A, then work K1, P1 ribbing decreasing one st on first row back to 32 sts.

Work 3 rows of ribbing and bind off in ribbing.

### Thumb:

Carefully remove waste yarn catching the live stitches on two needles. Top needle will have 5 sts and the bottom one will have 6 stitches. With another needle, pick up and knit 2 sts between the top and bottom needle on the right hand side, K3 from next needle. With another needle, K3 and pick up and knit 2 sts between the bottom and the top needles. With another needle, K5. There should be 3 needles with 5 sts each. Knit 5 rounds and bind off loosely.

Weave in all ends.

## Scarf

Materials: Cascade Yarns Cloud 9: 50% Wool, 50% Angora: 1 skein each, color A #149 dk brown, color B #134 reddish brown, color C # 135 beige, Color D #186 dk rose.  
NOTE: if you are also making the wristers to match, you will only need one more ball of color A for both.  
Size 9 needles  
Stitch markers  
Yarn needle

Size: 7" wide by 46" long approx.

Gauge: 4 sts = 1", 6 rows = 1" in Stockinette stitch (st st)

PM= place marker

Yf = bring yarn to the front of work

Yb= bring yarn back to the back of work.

RS = right side facing

Sl = slip stitch to right needle purlwise

### SCARF

The body of the scarf is worked in st st with 4 sts on each side for an edge in garter st. (Knit every row)

Each color change has 2 interchange rows worked between using the new color.

With color A, cast on 30 sts. Work in garter stitch for 6 rows.

Set up rows: Row 1: (RS) K4, PM, K22, PM, K4.

Row 2: K4, P22, K4.

Repeat these two rows once more. Color B will be next.

Interchange Rows:

Row 1: (RS) With next color, K4, \*K1, yf, sl 1, yb; rep from \* across to next marker, K4.

Row 2: K4, \*P1, yb, sl 1, yf; rep from \* across to next marker, yb, K4.

Work 6 rows in st st with color B.

Work the following color sequence, working the number of rows indicated after the color in  
indicated in st st

after the Interchange rows have been completed with the new color.

Color A: 8 rows

Color C: 14 rows

Color A: 4 rows

Color D: 6 rows

Color A: 2 rows

Color B: 16 rows

Color A: 8 rows

Color C: 4 rows

Color A: 2 rows

Color D: 14 rows

Color A: 8 rows

Color B: 4 rows

Color A: 14 rows.

Now work back the other way reversing the order so both ends will be the same. 14 rows of A  
will be center

back. (B for 4 rows, A for 8 rows, D for 14 rows, etc)

End working 6 rows in garter stitch and bind off. Weave in all ends.
