



**Double Breasted Vest (B131)  
Using Cascade Pima Silk Pattern**



## DOUBLE BREASTED PIMA SILK VEST

MATERIALS CASCADE YARNS PIMA SILK: 7/ 8/ 8/ 9/ 9/ 10 SKS

BUTTONS: 2 = 1" NEEDLES: #7

TENSION: 5 STS = 1" IN GARTER STITCH (GTR ST)

SIZES: FINISHED BUST 33"/ 36"/ 40"/ 44"/ 48"/ 52"

FINISHED LENGTH: 22"

VEST IS WORKED IN 1 PIECE TO THE ARM HOLES/WHEN WORKING DECREASES ON THE RIGHT SIDE EDGE DO: K2, SSK. WHEN WORKING DECREASES ON THE LEFT SIDE EDGE DO: 4 STS FROM END OF ROW, K2TOG, K2.

SSK=SLIP AS TO KNIT, SLIP AS TO KNIT, PUT LEFT NEEDLE FROM THE BACK THRU BOTH STS AND KNIT THEM TOGETHER AND SLIDE OFF THE LEFT NEEDLE.

K2TOG=KNIT 2 STS TOGETHER AND SLIDE BOTH STS OFF LEFT NEEDLE.

YO=YARN OVER NEEDLE

BACK:

CAST ON 194/ 204/ 224/ 244/ 264/ 284 STS AND KNIT FOR 9 ½". WITH RIGHT SIDE FACING, K3, YO, K2TOG, K15, YO, K2TOG, KNIT TO END. WORK 1 ROW MORE. (SHOULD BE 10") DECREASE 1 ST AT EACH EDGE EVERY OTHER ROW 27/ 27/ 29/ 29/ 31/ 31 TIMES. AT THE SAME TIME, WHEN YOU HAVE 14" FROM CAST ON EDGE TOTAL, SHAPE ARM HOLES: AT THIS POINT YOU SHOULD HAVE 12 DECREASES COMPLETED (170, 180, 200, 220, 240, 260 STS REMAINING). KNIT 37/ 39/ 43/ 45/ 47/ 49 FOR RIGHT FRONT, BIND OFF 10/ 10/ 12/ 12/ 14/ 14 STS, WORK 80/ 85/ 90/ 95/ 100 STS TOTAL FOR BACK, BIND OFF 10/ 10/ 12/ 12/ 14/ 14 STS FOR OTHER ARM HOLE, WORK REMAINING 37/ 39/ 43/ 45/ 47/ 49 STS TOTAL FOR LEFT FRONT.

CONTINUE TO DO THE DECREASES AS BEFORE AND WHEN LEFT FRONT MEASURES 8" AND PLACE ON HOLD. JOIN YARN TO THE BACK STS AND KNIT FOR 8" AND PLACE ON HOLD. JOIN YARN TO RIGHT FRONT AND CONTINUE TO WORK DECREASES AS BEFORE. WHEN RIGHT FRONT MEASURES 8" ABOVE ARM HOLE, PLACE ON HOLD. PLACE RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER AND USING A 3<sup>RD</sup> NEEDLE, KNIT TOGETHER 1 ST FROM THE FRONT AND BACK NEEDLES, REPEAT THIS STEP, PASS THE 1<sup>ST</sup> ST OVER THE 2<sup>ND</sup> ST AND OFF THE NEEDLE=KNIT TOGETHER BIND OFF. REPEAT FOR OTHER SHOULDER AND CONTINUE TO BIND OFF BACK NECK STS ALSO.

NO FINISHING IS NEEDED EXCEPT TO TUCK IN THE ENDS AND SEW ON THE BUTTONS. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO A SINGLE CROCHET AROUND THE EDGES WOULD BE FINE.
