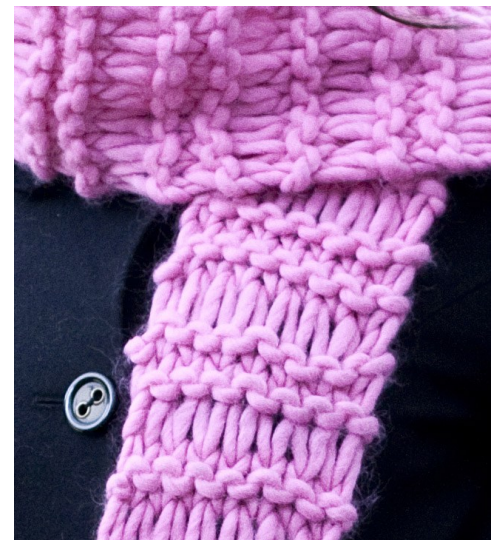

Magnum One Skein Scarf

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A quick scarf that is easy to knit in one evening.

Materials: 1 skein Magnum – Shown in Color 9478

Size US 19 Straight Needles

Crochet Hook – for attaching fringe

Abbreviations: K – Knit

YO – Yarn Over

Before Casting on – cut 12” pieces of yarn for the fringe – around 20 lengths should be sufficient

unless you would like more fringe

Cast on 8 stitches (or more for desired width)

Row 1 – Knit all stitches

Row 2 – K1, *YO, K1* - repeat from * until end of row

Row 3– K1, *drop YO, K1* repeat from * until end of row

Repeat rows 1-3 until desired length.

Knit one row.

Bind off.

Attach fringe to ends –Fold each piece in half and use crochet hook to pull through the edge of the scarf. Pull the 2 ends through the loop and tighten.
