Childs Alternative Cable Pullover

Knitted Measurements

Chest size 1 (2, 3) years = 24 (26, 28) in.

Length 13(14, 15)in.

Sleeve Length 8 1/4(9 1/2, 11)in.

Gauge 12 1/2 sts & 23 rows = 4 in.

Materials 3 (4, 4)100 gr./3.5 oz, each approx 109 yds) balls of 109 Tweed LE, Cascade Yarns Peruvian highland wool 90%, Donegal (tweed) 10%, 1 pair # 10 knitting needle (or size to obtain gauge) 1 pair # 10 16 in. circular needles, 1 cable needle

Patt Seed St. Row 1 K1, P1.

Row 2 K the P sts, & P the K sts

Alternate cable patt (13 sts)

Row 1 (RS) P2, K9, P2

Row 2 K2, P9, K2

Row 3 P2, slip next 3 sts. To cn hold in front, K3, then k 3 from cn, K3 P2

Rows 4 & 6 repeat row 2

Row 5 repeat row 1

Row 7 P2, K3, slip 3 sts to cn hold in back, K3 K3 from cn, P2

Row 8 repeat row 2

Repeat these 8 rows for patt

Note * when 1 set of instructions are indicated it applies to all sizes.

Back With # 10 straight needles cast on 40 (42, 45) sts. Work in K3 P2, rib for 1 in. On last row inc. 1 (3, 4) sts evenly spaced = 41(45, 49) sts. Work patt as follow: 14 (16, 18) sts in seed st patt, 13 sts in cable patt, 14 (16, 18) sts in seed st patt. Work this way till piece measures 8 1/4 (9, 9 3/4) in. from the beg.

Armhole shaping Bind off 3 (4, 4) sts each end 1 x. Work even till piece measures 12 1/2 (13 1/2, 14 1/2) from beg. Work across 11(16, 18) sts, place center 13 sts on a holder, join a 2nd ball of yarn & work across 11(16, 18) sts. Bind off 2 sts at neck edge 1 (2, 2) times each. Work even till piece measures 13 (14, 15) in from beg or desired length to shoulder.

Front Work as for back till 11 1/2 (12 1/2, 13 1/2) in from beg. Place center 9 sts on a holder. Working with separate balls of yarn as for back, Bind off 2 sts at neck edge 2(3,3) TIMES = 12(14, 16) STS ON EACH SIDE. Then dec 1 st at neck edge on small size only= 11(16, 18) sts. Work even as for back.

Sleeves Cast on 20 (25, 25) st. rib as for back inc. 1 (2, 3) sts on last row= 21(27, 29) sts. Work patt as follow: 4 (7,8) sts in seed st, 13 sts in cable, 4 (7, 8) sts in seed st. Inc. 1 sts each end every 4th row till 33 (37 41) sts. Work even till 8 1/4 (9 1/2, 11) in from the beg or desired sleeve length. Bind off.

Finishing Block pieces to measurements. Sew shoulder seams. With # 10 circular needle & (RS) facing, start at left front shoulder & pick up 10 (10, 11) sts, then 9 sts from front neck holder, 10 (10, 11) sts from right front neck edge, then 6 (6, 7) st along back neck edge, 13 sts from back neck holder, 6 (6, 7) sts at back neck edge. Working in the round place a marker at the beg of the row. & work in K3 P2 rib inc. 1(1,4)sts on 1st row. Rib for 4 rows & bind off in patt.
