



COWL NECK WRAP OR HEAD COVER
USING CASCADE YARN'S
BABY ALPACA CHUNKY



DESIGNED BY
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Cowl Neck Wrap or Head Cover

This feels like luxury! Wrap your neck in this soft and light, snuggly warmth. Its texture is developed in one easy round. This yarn is light as a feather, and at the same time being baby alpaca lends warmth. For a head cover, double the length.



Skill Level: Intermediate

Size: Adult

Finished circumference: Cowl 24" circ. x 8", Head Cover 24" circ. x 15"

Materials: Cowl: 1 skein; Head Cover 2 skeins Cascade Baby Alpaca Chunky (100% baby Alpaca 100g. 108 yards), color 562, blue, or 565, cream

One 16" Size US #11 circular needle

Blunt sewing needle

Gauge: 13 sts and 18 rnds = 4" in patt

Pattern

Rnd 1: *P1, K1, P1, K3*, rep * to * to end of rnd

Rnd 2: * P1, K1, P1, yrn¹, P3tog, yrn *, rep * to *

Rnds 3-5: *P1, K1, P1, K3*, rep * to * to end of rnd

Lower Edge

Cast on 77 sts with German Long Tail Cast on or a very stretchy cast on. Join in a circle taking care not to twist sts.

Cowl: Repeat Pattern Rnds 1-5 until approx. 3 yards of yarn rem

Bind off with sewn bind off*

Head Cover: Repeat Pattern Rnds 1-5 until approx. 15” long. End with rnd 5.
Bind off with sewn bind off*

*Sewn bind off: Cut a length of yarn 3x the circumference. Thread onto a blunt needle. On the left knitting needle, insert the blunt needle purl wise into two loops. Draw the yarn through. Insert the blunt needle back into just the right hand loop and pull through. On this first repeat; place the right hand loop onto the right knitting needle. For all other stitches, drop the right loop off the knitting needle. Repeat two purl wise, one knit wise until all the stitches are used up. Attributed to Elizabeth Zimmerman

¹Yrn = “yarn round needle”: With yarn in front, wrap yarn over needle to the back, down, and around to the front
