## Tri-Cornered Hat

1 skein Cascade 128, or if multi-colored, 2 skeins will make 2 hats

Size 10.5 needles, or needles to get gauge, 16" circular

Stitch marker

Large button of your dreams

Gauge: 3 sts per inch

Sizes: 16 (18, 20, 22, 23)"

The stitch numbers are multiples of 4. They allow for a stockinette stitch rolled edge, for k1p1 ribbing or for k2,p2 ribbing. Your choice

Cast on 44 (52, 60, 68, 72) sts.

Join in a round, marking beginning, and start knitting or ribbing. If ribbing, continue for 1½ (1 ½, 2, 2,2)". Change to st st and continue knitting away. If you want to do stripes, change at top of ribbing and every 8(8, 10, 10, 10) rows. Continue thus until there are 5 stripes altogether, ending with the first color. Bind off.

Divide top edge into thirds. Bringing the middle of each third to the center and holding wrong sides together, sew together just below the bound off edge. The edges will stand up.

I-cord: Cast on 3 sts, work i-cord for 14" for desired length to make 3 or however many you want) loops. Sew together at the bottom and attach to the top of the hat.

Note: Don't feel that you have to follow these directions to a tee. It is your hat! Make it your own!
