

Etoile Lacy Crossover
Using Cascade Bollicine Etoile

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Etoile Lacey Cross-over Sweater

Materials: Cascade Yarns Bollicine Etoile: 6,7,8 skeins
Knitting needles size 5, circular & dbl pointed

Gauge: 22 sts = 4"; 7 rows = 1"

Finished Measurements: approx. 32-34", 38-40", 42-44" Sizing adjustable with ties.

Lace Border Pattern

Row 1: K5, K1, K2 tog, K4, (yo, K1) twice, SSK, skip next st and K in 2nd st, then K in 1st st (twist st made), K3.

Row 2 and all even rows: K3, P to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 3: K5, K1, K2 tog, K3, yo, K1, yo, K2, SSK, twist st, K3.

Row 5: K5, K1, K2 tog, K2, yo, K1, yo, K3, SSK, twist st, K3.

Row 7: K5, K1, K2 tog, (K1, yo) twice, K4, SSK, twist st, K3.

Row 9: K5, K1, K2 tog, yo, K1, yo, K5, SSK, twist st, K3.

Row 11: K5, K1, K2 tog, (K1, yo) twice, K4, SSK, twist st, K3.

Row 13: K5, K1, K2 tog, K2, yo, K1, yo, K3, SSK, twist st, K3.

Row 15: K5, K1, K2 tog, K3, yo, K1, yo, K2, SSK, twist st, K3.

Row 17: K5, K2 tog, K4, (yo, K1) twice, SSK, twist st, K3.

Row 19: K5, K1, K2 tog, K5, yo, K1, yo, SSK, twist st, K3.

Row 20: repeat row 2.

Repeat rows 1-20 for pattern.

Back

Cast on 89, 101, 117 sts. Work in stockinette stitch (k one row, P one row) until back measures 8 ½, 9, 10" or desired length to underarm. Bind off 4, 6, 7 sts at the beg of the next two rows. Dec 1 st each side every other row 3, 5, 7 times. 75, 79, 89 sts. Work until armhole measures 8 ½", 9", 9 ½".

Shape Shoulders

Bind off 7, 7, 7 sts at the beg of the next 4, 2, 2 rows. Bind off 7, 7, 8 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows. Bind off 0, 8, 8 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows. Bind off remaining sts

Right Front

Cast on 88, 99, 110 sts. Knit one row. Purl one row. K 21 sts and place on a holder, K rest of row. Purl next row. Dec 1 st at neck edge every other row working until piece measures same as back to armhole. Shape armholes to correspond to back at the same time continue dec every other row at neck edge until there are 4, 6, 7 sts remaining. Continue even until armhole length matches that of back and work shoulder shaping as for back.

Left Front

Cast on 88, 99, 110 sts. Knit one row. P 21 sts and put on holder. Work to correspond to Right Front.

Sew shoulder seams. (The lace panel will be sewn to the remaining

Lace Panel

Pick up 21 sts from Right Front. With right side facing begin Lace Border Pattern. (K5 will be at the neck edge). Work Lace Border Pattern until piece measures to shoulder ending with a right side row. Bind off until 5 sts remain (K sts border) Continue on these 5 sts knitting until measures across back to other shoulder. Bind off and sew in place. Pick up 21 sts from Left Front and work to correspond. Sew in place.

Sleeves (2)

Cast on 21 sts and work Lace Panel pattern for 5 repeats ending with row 20. bind off 20 sts. Leaving the last st on the needle, pick up and knit 66 sts along side of panel. Purl one row, Inc 1 st each side every other row to 97, 100, 104 sts. Work even until piece measures 17", 17 1/2", 17, 1/2" or desired length to armhole.

Armhole Shaping

Bind off 4, 6, 7 st at the beg of next two rows. Dec 1 st each side every other row 3, 5, 7 times. Dec 1 st each side every row 26, 22, 20 times. Med & Large only: work one row even, dec 1 st each side once. Bind off 3, 4, 4 sts at the beg of the next 4 rows. Bind off remaining sts.

Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams leaving about 1/2" opening 1/4" from the bottom of the Right side seam. (For tie to go through)

Bottom Cord Trim and Ties

With circular needles pick up and knit around bottom edge making one stitch in each st around. Set aside.

With short double pointed needles begin I cord by casting on 5 sts. Knit 5. Do not turn. *Push sts to the right side of the needle and knit 5. * repeat between *'s to make I cord. Work for 22, 24, 26". Attach I cord to sweater by knitting the first 4 sts, then K together the last st with the first st on the right front. You have 5 sts on the short needle as before. Continue in this manner knitting the last I cord st with the next st from the sweater bottom all the way around to the other side. Continue the I cord for the second tie. Bind off. Weave in all ends. Steam slightly if necessary.
