



**Pink Tanktop
Using Cascade Fixation Pattern**



Pink Tanktop

Size: 38

Materials: Fixation yarn, 3 balls color pink (6085); 1 pair of plastic knitting needles with 4,5 mm and 1 crochet hook #2 (1,75 mm).

Stitches: purl (p), knit (k), and single crochet (sc).

Instructions:

Front and Back: cast on 67 stitches on knitting needles and work in fantasy stitch, following diagram 1. When you have 30 cm shape armholes, casting off at both sides, at each 2 rows, 4 stitches 1 x, 2 stitches 1 x, 1 stitch 5 x. When 37 cm shape low neck casting off the 9 central stitches and continue working each side separately, casting off on the low-neck side, at each 2 rows, 4 stitches 1 x and 1 stitch 2 x. When 46 cm from beginning, cast off all remaining stitches. Make the same on the other side. Make the back as same as front. Sew sides and shoulders. Using the crochet hook, make a single crochet round all over low neck and armholes.

Gauge: a 5 x 5 cm square (using knitting needles # 4,5) = 11 stitches x 15 rows in fantasy stitch (diagram 1).
