



**Tube Top with Arm Bands
Using Cascade Fixation Pattern**



Tube Top with arm bands Using Cascade Fixation Pattern

Size: 38

Materials: fixation yarn, 1 ball color variegated (9251), and 3 balls color pink (6133); 1 pair of plastic knitting needles with 4,5 mm and 1 aluminum crochet hook # 2 (1,75 mm).

Stitches: purl (p), knit (k), chain (ch), slipstitch (slst), single crochet (sc), and double crochet (dc).

Instructions:

Front and Back: using pink yarn and knitting needles cast on 70 stitches and work in stocking stitch (right side in knit, wrong side in purl). When you have 25 cm from beginning cast off all stitches. Make the back as same as front.

Sleeves: using variegated yarn and knitting needles cast on 40 stitches and work in stocking stitch. When 13 cm from beginning cast off all stitches. Sew sides of the blouse and sleeves. Sew the sleeves on 3 cm of the sides of the blouse. Using the crochet hook and variegated yarn make the finishing around low neck and sleeves with a single-crochet round.

To make the crochet disc use the variegated yarn making 8 ch, joining into a ring with a slipstitch and working in rounds following diagram 1 to the end. Sew it to the front of the blouse, 4 cm below low neck.

Gauge: a 5 x 5 cm square (using knitting needles # 4,5) = 9 stitches x 16 rows in stocking stitch (right side in knit, wrong side in purl).

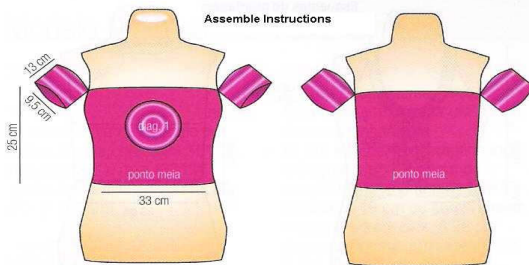
