Baby Optical Conclusions

Materials: 4 Cherub DK #05 MC , 1 Cherub DK (Variegated) #512 CC
Needles: #3 & #5 or needles to obtain gauge
3 Stitch Holders
No 3 circular needles or set DPN.

Buttons: Optional 5 for the cardigan

Sizes: Finished length 11 ½"

Chest: 20"/22"/24"

Sleeve: 7 ½" / 8" / 8 ½"

Tension: 5 ½ sts = 1" & 8 Rows

Pattern Stitch:

1 x 1 Rib = K1, P1 OR Garter stitch Ribbing

Knit the knits & purl the purls on all remaining rows.

Band: Garter St. Rib : Knit every Row **or** 1 x 1 Rib

K = Knit, P = Purl. SH= Stitch Holder

SL1= Slip Stitch from one needle to the next without knitting it.

PATTERN

SLIP STITCH USING 2 COLOURS

1. CC K
2. CC K
3. MC K4, (SL 1, K5) REPEAT TO ENDING WITH K3
4. MC P4 (SL1, P 1, P 5) REPEAT TO ENDING WITH K3.
5. MC K4 (SL, 1, K5) REPEAT TO ENDING WITH K3
6. MC P4 (SL 1, P 5) REPEAT TO ENDING WITH K3.

These 6 rows form pattern:

This sweater is worked in 2 pieces starting at the cuff and sewn together in the center back only for cardigan and sew center front & Back for pullover. The neck and bottom edges are picked up and worked last.

**Starting at the Sleeve Band (This is the *left* side of the)garment

With #3 needles & MC cast on 31 sts. Work either gtr st. 1 x 1 rib OR rib for 7 rows

Row 8: increase evenly to 45 sts.

Row 9 : change to #5 needles and follow Slip st. Pattern. Keeping pattern correct, Increase 1 st at each end every 4th to 79 sts.

Continue in pattern until sleeve measures 7 ½ ", 8, 8 ½ ".

At the start of the next 2 rows cast on 36sts, with CC. (151 TOTAL)

Continue for another 2 ¼", 2 ¾", 3 ¼". Finishing with a **CC** row.

Shape Neck As Follows:

Right side Facing you

Row 1 & 2: MC Knit ******

***Row 3: CC Knit Slip Stitch Pattern for 75 sts leaving 76 stitches on the needle for later.

Row 4: CC P Slip Stitch Pattern

Row 5: CC K Slip Stitch Pattern

Row 6: CC P Slip Stitch Row Pattern

Row 7 & 8: MC Knit 2 rows***

Repeat from ****** *to ******* at the same time

At Neck Edge you will decrease 1 st every other row 4 times (71)

Continue until 4 CC row groups have been completed ending with MC.

Place stitches on stitch holder.

Return to the 76 Stitches. Work the same reverse color pattern and shape the neck as follow:

At the neck edge only bind off 8 sts, 1 x, and then decrease 1 st every other row 8 times. (60 sts)

Continue on these 60 stitches in slips stitch pattern until 5 row groups have been completed ending with CC Place these stitches on stitch holder

Cardigan. Change to smaller needles and knit 8 rows. Remember to make button holes evenly down one side.

Right Side:

Work as left side Reversing the shaping working with the 76 stitches first then the 75

Graft the front to the front and the back to the back.

Hold 2 stitch holders together with the MC near to you and with another needle, knit one from the front SH and one from the Back SH 2 times. You now have 2 stitches on your RH needles. Pass the first stitch over the Second. Repeat knit one from the front SH and one from the Back passing the 1st stitch over the 2nd. Until the end. **MAKE SURE YOUR SLIP STITCHES MATCH UP.**

Neck band: pick up 111 stitches evenly around neck and work 8 rows.

Bottom band: pick up 170 stitches evenly around the bottom and work 8 rows.
