# RIBBED MOCK T -NECK

USING

**CASCADE FIXATION YARN**

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## Ribbed Mock T-Neck

Materials: 6 skeins Cascade Fixation

Circular # 6 needles

Markers

Stitch Holders

Gauge: 6 ½ sts = 1" in rib pattern not stretched

Garment is form fitting

Sweater is worked in one piece to the armholes. Pattern is written for basic tank with directions for sleeves and a jewel neck or Mock Turtle-neck, so sweater can be made as a tank with a jewel neck, a jewel neck top with sleeves, a sleeveless mock turtle or a mock turtle with sleeves.

**Pattern:** K2, P1 if on the reverse, work sts as they present themselves.

Cast on 198 (222, 246) sts on circular needles. Place marker at middle point 98 (111, 123) sts and at the end, being careful not to twist the sts on the needle. Work pattern sts in the round for 8 ½, ( 9, 9 ½ ) inches. Starting at beginning of row bind off for armholes as follows: Bind off 5 stitches, work until 5 sts before next marker, bind off those 5 sts and the next 5 after the marker. Work until the last 5 sts and bind them off. Now you will be working on the back 89 (101,113)sts

**Shape armholes and follows:** On Right Side (RS): Knit 2 SSK continue in pattern to the last 4 sts, K2tog K@. Repeat this armhole shaping 4 more times until there are 79 (91,103) sts left. Continue in pattern until back measures 7 (7 ½,8) inches from armholes bind off. Shape back neck: on RSs keeping in pattern work across 29(33,37)sts. Place center 21 (25,29) sts. Work 2 more rows. Bind off.

**Front:** Work same as for back until piece measures 5" from armhole bind off. Work across 33, (37,41) sts put center 13 (17,21) sts on a holder, work next 33 (37, 41) sts. Working sides sep> Shape neck as follows. At neck edge bind off 3 sts once, 2 sts twice, 1 sts 5 times [21 (25, 29)] sts. Continue until same length as back. Bind off.

**Finishing:** Sew shoulder seams together. With circular needles pick up approximately 105 (110,115) sts around neck. For Jewel neck knit 2 rows. Bind off loosely. For Mock Turtle neck: K2p 1 rib for 2 ½" Bind off in pattern.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 66 (69, 72) sts. Work in Rib pattern for 3 ¾" (K2, P1 on knit side, P1,K2 on purl side) Shape cap: bind off 4 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows until there are 12 sts left. Bind off. Make 2.
