Cherub Aran Baby Blooms Beanie/ Cap

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An Anne Smith Pattern

On # 7 Needles in Stocking Stitch = 26sts = 5", 27 Rows = 4" or size required to give correct tension.

MEASUREMENTS

To Fit head	14	15	16	17	18
Length to decrease	5	5 ½	5 1/5	6	6

MATERIALS USED

Cascade Yarns Cherub Aran

- 100G (240 yds) 55% Ny-

lon, 45% Acrylic

Markers = 6

**US - 7 (4.50mm) Circular
Needles**

Pattern Note: 14" divided by 5 multiply by 26 = 73 stitches

CC contrast Color

MC = Main Color

YF = Yarn to front as if to knit

YB = Yarn to the back

SSK= Knit 2 tog through back of loops

Measure Child head.

Using Cascade Cherub Aran Yarn

Example Childs Head is 14", (15,16,17,18)inches

Using DPN or circular needles CO 75,(80, 85, 90, 95) sts

Join to create a circle being careful not to twist.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2 Purl

Repeat last 2 rows 3 times

Row 9 - 12 Knit

Row 13: (RS) with CC, P2, (YF, Sl 2 knitways, YB P2) across, ending with P2

Row 14: (CC, K 2, Slip 2, K2), Repeat to end

Row 15 - 16: Repeat Row 1 & 2

Row 17-23: MC, Knit

Row 24-25: CC, Knit

Row 26-27: MC, Knit

Row 28-29 CC, Knit

Row 30-: Repeat Rows 24-27 once

Continue in MC until work measures 5, (5 ½, 5 ½, 6, 6,) inches (or length desired to)

Divide for decreasing

Place Marker, K 15(16,17,19) place marker * Repeat from * to end (5 decreases)

Next Round,: *SSK, knit to next marker, slip marker over * repeat to end.

Continue knit the last round till you have 5 stitches left. Break yarn, thread yarn through 5 stitches and secure.
