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3(3,4,4,5) balls Cascade Pacific yarn #26  
gauge: 20 sts/4"  
Size 7 needles or size needed to obtain gauge  
4 1" buttons

2(4,6,8,10) yrs.  
24 (26,28,30,32)"

## Back:

Cast on 67(71,77,83,89) sts. Work seed st for 13(13,15,15 17) rows. Change to st st and decrease one st each side at 3(3 ½, 3 ¾, 4, 4)" and 2 times more at same interval, 2 sts from each edge by knitting 2, k 2 tog, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2. 61

(65,71,77,83) sts. Continue until back measures 12 1/2)(13 ½, 14 ½, 15 ½, 16 )" from cast on edge. Beginning of armhole: work each edge in 5(5,5,7,7) sts in seed st. and center sts in st st for 5 ½(6,6 ¾, 7 ½, 8 ¼) more in. Place sts. on holder 60(65,70,77,82) sts.

## Left Front:

Cast on 40(43,46,50,53) sts. On first row (ws), work 8(8,10,10,12) sts. seed st, pm, **k1 p1** across 14 sts, pm, seed st to end. Continue as established for 13(13,15,15 17) rows total.

Rs: k to first marker, slip marker, work row 1 of Lace Chart, slip marker, seed st to end (front placket).

Continue working lace as described, while keeping 8 (8,10,10,12) front edge sts. in seed and rest in st st.. Decrease 3 sts on side edge as for back (beg of rs row).

Work until front matches back to armhole. Last row is right side. Working 5 (5, 5, 7, 7) armhole edge sts in seed st, continue as established until armhole measures 5 ½ (6, 6 ¾, 7 ½, 8 ¼) in. Cast off 4(5,5,6,6) sts. at front edge. Place remaining sts. on holder. 33(35,38,41,44)sts.

Mark front placket for 4 buttons, starting ½" from top and spacing 2(2,2 ½,2 ½, 2 ¾)" between.

## Right Front:

Work as for left, reversing shaping. Work 4 buttonholes to correspond with buttons as follows: (rs) k4, bind off 2, k2, work to end of row. On following row, cast on 2 sts over bo sts using backward loop method.

Join fronts to back, right sides facing, with 3 needle bindoff 15(18,19,23,24)sts on each shoulder, leaving lace section and front seed st placket on holder 18(19,19,20,20)sts

## Hood:

Place 18(19,19,20,20) sts from left front on needle, then 30(29,32,31,34) remaining back sts., then 18 (19,19,20,20) right front sts. 66(67,70,71,74) sts. With rs facing, attach yarn to right front edge and, keeping remaining seed st and lace in pattern, work back in st st, increasing 1(0,1,0,1)st in first row. 67, (67,71,71,75) sts

Mark center stitch. Knit in st st, keeping edge in pattern and inc 1 st (kflsb) each side of center stitch every 6 rows for 6(7,7,7,8) times.

When hood measures 9 ½,(10,10 ½, 11, 11 ½) in. , and after a ws row, fold in half, right sides together and join with a 3 needle bindoff.

**Sleeves:**

Right band:

Cast on 15 ( 15, 17, 17, 17) sts. Purl one row. rs: work lace chart, over 8 sts, pm, then work last 7 (7,9,9,9) sts. in seed st. ws: Work as established, slipping first st on rs purlwise. Continue until cuff measures 7 ½ (8, 8 ¼, 8 ½, 9) in., ending after a ws row. Bind off. (Mark this as right sleeve band.)

Left band:

Work as for right band, but 7(7,9,9,9) seed sts. will be at beg of rs rows, slipped st at end of lace (bring yarn to front and slip purlwise).

Pickup for sleeves:

With rs facing, pick up and k 34(36,38,42,44) sts. along non-seed st edge of each band. Work sleeves in st st, inc. one stitch each side, one st in from edge every 6 rows 6(7,8,9,10) times. Use kflsb method 46(50,54,60,64 sts). When sleeve measures 10 (10 ½, 11 ½, 12 ½. 13 ½) in. from bottom, cast off on k side.

Sew sleeves to shoulders and seam underarms and sides. Add buttons and enjoy!

pm - place marker

3 needle bindoff – holding right sides together, and having sts. on parallel needles, bind off with 3<sup>rd</sup> needle, knitting one st. from front together with one st. from back.

Kflsb – k into front of stitch, sl back of stitch. On next row, purl both stitches.

yf – yarn forward
