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## A Touch of Lace

### Baby Set

#### Using Cascade Cherub 4 Ply

Sizes: to fit chest sizes 18in, 20in, 22in  
Materials: Cascade's Cherub 50 g. ball, 4 balls/set  
Needles size 1 and 3  
Gauge: 14 sts and 18 rows = 2 in over st.st. on size 3 needles

#### SWEATER

**BACK:** Using size 1 needles, cast on 71 (77,85) sts.

1<sup>st</sup> Row: K1, \*P1, K1, rep. From \* to end.

2<sup>nd</sup> Row: P1, \*K1, P1, rep. From \* to end.

Rep. the last 2 rows 5 (6,7) times more.

Change to size 3 needles and st. st. (1 row knit, 1 row purl)

Work 10 (12, 14) rows in st.st.

#### Begin Pattern:

1<sup>st</sup> Row: K5 (5,3), yf, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., \*K4, yf, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., rep. from \* to last 4 (4, 2) sts, K4 (4, 2).

2<sup>nd</sup> and Alt rows: Purl.

3<sup>rd</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Rows: K3 (3, 1), \* K2 tog, yf, K1, yf, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K1, rep. from \* to last 2 (2,0) sts, K2 (2, 0).

5<sup>th</sup> Row: K2 (2, 0), K2 tog, \*yf, K3, yf, sl 1, K2 tog., p.s.s.o., rep. from \* to last 7 (7, 5) sts., yf, K3, yf, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K2 (2, 0).

7<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 17<sup>th</sup> Rows: Same as 1<sup>st</sup> Row.

13<sup>th</sup> Row: K3 (3, 1), \* yf, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K1, K2 tog, yf, K1, rep from \* to last 2 (2,0) sts, K2 (2,0).

15<sup>th</sup> Row: K4 (4, 2), yf, sl 1, K2 tog. p.s.s.o., \*yf, K3, yf, sl 1, K2 tog, p.s.s.o., rep. from \* to last 4 (4, 2) sts. Yf, K4 (4, 2).

18<sup>th</sup> Row: Purl.

Work 10 (14, 16) rows in st.st.

#### Shape Armholes:

Cast off 5 (5, 6) sts at beg. of next 2 rows.

Next Row: K1, K2 tog, K to last 3 sts, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K1.

Next Row: Purl.

Repeat the last 2 rows until 31 (33, 35) sts remain, finishing on a P row.

Next Row: K1, K2 tog. K to last 3 sts, sl 1, K 1 p.s.s.o., K1.

Next Row: P1, P 2 tog t.b.l., P to last 3 sts, P 2 tog., P1.

Repeat the last 2 rows once more. 23 (25, 27) sts. Sl sts. onto a st. holder. Break off yarn.

#### FRONT:

Work exactly as instructions given for Back until 37 (39, 41) sts remain, finishing on a K row.

#### Shape Neck:

Next Row: P 23 (25, 27), sl the last 9 (11, 13) sts. just worked onto a st. holder, P to end. Continue on last set of sts as follows:

Next Row: K1, K 2 tog., K to last 2 sts, K 2 tog.

Next Row: P 2 tog., P to end.

Next Row: K1, K 2 tog., K to last 2 sts., K 2 tog.

Next Row: Purl

Repeat the last 2 rows once more. 7 sts.

Next Row: K1, K 2 tog., K 2, K 2 tog.

Next Row: P2, P 2 tog., P1.

Next Row: K1, K2 tog., K1.

Next Row: P 2 tog., P1.

K 2 tog. Fasten off. With right side facing, rejoin yarn at neck edge.

Next Row: K 2 tog., K to last 3 sts., sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K1.

Next Row: P to last 2 sts, P 2 tog.

Next Row: k 2 tog., K to last 3 sts., sl 1, K1,

p.s.s.o., K1.

Next Row: Purl.

Repeat the last 2 rows once more. 7 sts.

Next Row: K 2 tog., K2, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K1.

Next Row: P1, P 2 tog. Tbl, P2.

Next Row: K1, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K1

Next Row: P1, P 2 tog. Tbl. Then K 2 tog and fasten off.

#### SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using size 1 needles, cast on 39 (41, 43) sts. Work 11 (13, 15) rows in rib as given for Back.

Next Row: (Inc. Row) Rib 4 (5, 6), inc. in next st., \*rib 5, inc. in next st., rep. from \* to last 4 (5, 6) sts., rib 4 (5, 6). 45 (47, 49) sts. Change to size 3 needles and st.st.

Work 4 rows.

Inc. 1 st at each end of the needle on the next and every following 6<sup>th</sup> row until 49 (53, 57) sts are on needle.

Work 3 (1, 3) rows.

#### Begin Pattern:

1<sup>st</sup> Row: K3 (5, 4) yf, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., \*K4, yf, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., rep. from \* to last 2 (4, 3) sts., K2 (4, 3).

2<sup>nd</sup> and Alt. Rows: Purl.

3<sup>rd</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> rows: K1, (3, 2), \*K2 tog, yf, K1, yf, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K1, rep. from \* to last 2 (2, 1)sts., K0 (2, 1)

5<sup>th</sup> Row: K 0 (2, 1), K2 tog., \*yf, K3, yf, sl 1, K 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rep from \* to last 5 (7, 6) sts., yf, K3, yf, sl 1,

K1, p.s.s.o., K0 (2, 1)

7<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> Rows: Same as Row 1.

13<sup>th</sup> Row: K1 (3, 2), \*yf, sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K1, K2 tog, yf, K1, rep. from \* to last 0 (2, 1) sts., K0 (2, 1).

15<sup>th</sup> Row: K2 (4, 3), yf, sl 1, K2 tog, p.s.s.o., \*yf, K3, yf, sl 1, K 2 tog, p.s.s.o., rep. from \* to last 2 (4, 3) sts., yf, K2 (4, 3).

18<sup>th</sup> Row: Purl.

Work 10 (14, 16) rows in st.st. inc., 1 st at each end of the needle on the 1<sup>st</sup> row. 51 (55, 59) sts.

#### ShapeTop:

Cast off 5 (5, 6) sts at beg. of next 2 rows. Work 2 rows.

Next Row: K1, K 2 tog. K to last 3 sts., sl 1, K1, p.s.s.o., K1.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Repeat the last 4 rows 0 (0, 1) times more, then the last 2 rows until 9 sts. remain, finishing on a P row. Slip sts. onto a safety pin. Break off yarn.

## PANTS

(Worked in one piece beginning at back waist edge.) Using size 1 needles cast on 69 (75, 83) sts. Work 14 rows in rib as given for Back of Sweater. Change to size 3 needles and st st. Work 2 rows in st st.

### Shape Back:

**Next Row:** K62 (68, 76), turn.

**Next Row:** Sl 1, P54 (60, 68), turn

**Next Row:** Sl 1, K 47 (53, 61), turn

**Next Row:** Sl 1, P 40 (46, 54), turn

**Next Row:** Sl 1, K33 (39, 47), turn

**Next Row:** Sl 1, P 26 (32, 40), turn.

**Next Row:** Sl 1, K19 (25, 33), turn.

**Next Row:** Sl 1, P 12 (18, 26) turn.

**Next Row:** Sl 1, K to end of row.

**Next Row:** P across all sts.

Continue in st st inc. 1 st at each end of the needle on the 5<sup>th</sup> and every following 10<sup>th</sup> row until 75 (81, 89) sts are on needle. Work 5 (7, 9) rows.

### Shape Leg Opening

Dec. 1 st at each end of the needle on the next and every following alt. Row until 65 (71, 81) sts remain, then each end of every row until 23 (25, 27) sts. Remain.

Work 10 (12, 14) rows.

Inc. 1 st at each end of the needle on the next and every following alt row until 33 (35, 37) sts are on the needle, then at each end of every row until 51 (53, 55) sts are on needle.

Cast on 12 (14, 17) sts at beg of next 2 rows 75 (81, 89) sts.

Dec. 1 st at each end of the needle on the 5<sup>th</sup>(7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>) row and every following 10<sup>th</sup> row until 69 (75, 83) sts. Remain.

Work 9 rows.

Change to size 1 needles.

Work 14 rows in rib as given for Back of Sweater. Cast off in rib.

## BOOTEES (Make 2)

Using size 1 needles, cast on 37 (37,39) sts.

Work 4 rows in rib as given for Back of Sweater.

Change to size 3 needles and st st. Work 2 rows.

### Begin Pattern:

**1<sup>st</sup> Row:** K3 (3, 4) yf, sl 1, K1, pssso, \*K4, yf, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from \* to last 2 (2,3) sts., K2 (2, 3).

**2<sup>nd</sup> and Alt. Rows:** Purl.

**3<sup>rd</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Rows:** K1 (1,2), \*K2 tog, yf, K1, yf, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, rep from \* to last 0 (0,1) st., K0 (0,1)

**5<sup>th</sup> Row:** K0 (0,1), K2 tog., \*yf, K3, yf, sl 1, K2 tog, pssso, rep from \* to last 5 (5, 6) sts., yf, K3, yf, sl 1, K1, pssso, K0 (0,1).

**7<sup>th</sup> 11<sup>th</sup>, and 17<sup>th</sup> Rows:** Same as 1<sup>st</sup> row.

**13<sup>th</sup> Row:** K1 (1,2), \*yf, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2 tog, yf, K1, rep from \* to last 0 (0,1)st., K0 (0,1).

**15<sup>th</sup> Row:** K2 (2,3), yf, sl 1, K2 tog, pssso, \*yf, K3, yf, sl 1, K2 tog, pssso., rep from \* to last 2 (2,3) sts, yf, K2 (2,3).

**18<sup>th</sup> Row:** Purl.

**19<sup>th</sup> Row:** (Make eyelet holes for cord) K1 (1,2) \*YF, k2 tog, k1,rep from \* to last 0 (0,1) stm K0 (0,1)

**Next Row:** Purl, dec. 1 st at each end of the needle for 18in. size only.

### Divide for Instep

**Next Row:** K23 (24,25), turn.

**Next Row:** P11, turn.

Work 14 (16,18) rows in st st on these 11 sts.

Break off yarn.

### Foot:

With right side facing, using right hand needle, rejoin yarn. Pick up and K10 (11, 12) sts evenly along row ends of instep, K11 sts from instep, pick up and K 10 (11,12) sts evenly down second side of instep and K remaining 12 (13, 14)sts. 55 (59, 63) sts.

Work 7 (9,9) rows in st st.

### Shape Sole:

**Next Row:** K1, \*K2 tog, K22 (24,26), sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, rep from \* to end. 51 (55,59)sts.

**Next and alt. Row:** Purl.

**Next Row:** K1, \*K2 tog, K20 (22,24), sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, rep from \* to end. 47 (51,55) sts.

**Next Row:** K1, \*K2 tog, K18 (20,22), sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, rep from \* to end. 43 (47,51)sts

Cast off purlwise.

## MAKING UP

### SWEATER

Pin sleeves into position leaving left back raglan open and sew in with backstitch.

### Neckband:

With right side of work facing and using size 1 needles, K9 from the left sleeve top, pick up and K 10 sts down left front neck, K9 (11,13) sts from center front, pick up and K 11 sts from right front neck, K9 sts from right sleeve top and 23 (25,27) sts from back neck. 71 (75,79) sts. Beginning with a 2<sup>nd</sup> row, work 15 rows in rib as given for back. Cast off loosely in rib. Fold neckband in half onto wrong side and slip stitch loosely in position. Join left back raglan by backstitching leaving 3 inches open from top of neckband.

### Raglan Opening Edging.

With right side of work facing, using size 3 hook, work 18 sc evenly along first side of opening, working through double thickness of neckband, then 18 sc evenly along second side of opening, ch 2, turn.
