# Kid Seta Boat Neck Pullover

**MATERIALS:** Cascade Kid Seta (61% Super Kid Mohair/35 % Silk / 4% Wool – 300 yds/25 g) - 5 (6, 7, 8, 9) balls

US US 3 (3.25mm) knitting needles.

Stitch holder.

## MEASUREMENTS:

To fit Bust: 30(32, 34, 36, 38, 40) inches

Finished circumference: Bust: 34.5(36.5, 39, 41, 43, 45) inches

Length to back neck: 26(26.75, 27.5, 28.25, 29, 30) inches

Sleeve seam: 19(19.5, 20, 20.5, 21, 21.5) inches

THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE SMALLEST SIZE, WITH THE LARGER SIZES IN BRACKETS; WHERE ONLY ONE FIGURE IS GIVEN, IT APPLIES TO ALL SIZES.

**TENSION:** For best results knit a swatch to check your gauge and adjust needle size appropriately

26sts and 36 rows = 4" (10cm) over stocking stitch using US 3 (3.25mm) needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**alt** = alternate; **beg** = begin(ning); **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease; **foll(s)** = follow(s)ing; **inc(s)** = increase(s); **k** = knit; **patt(s)** = pattern(s); **p** = purl; **rem** = remain; **rep** = repeat; **rev** = reverse; **R(W)SF** = right(wrong) side facing; **R(W)SR** = right(wrong) side row; **RW** = ribwise; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **st st** = stocking stitch; **tog** = together; **K2Tog** = knit 2 together

## STICHES USED:

### STOCKING STITCH:

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** RSF, one row k.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** WSF, one row p.

Rep these 2 rows.

## BACK:

Using US 3 (3.25mm) needles cast on 115(123;129;137;143;151)sts

Knit st st until work measures 6.7(6.3;5.9, 5.9, 5.9, 5.9) inches from beg ending with a WSR

## SHAPE SIDES:

Dec 1 st (K2tog) at each end of every foll alt row 4(1;0;0;0;0) times

Dec 1 st (K2Tog) every foll 4th row 6(9;7;3;2;2) times

Dec 1 st (K2Tog) every foll 6th row 0(0;3;7;8;8) times

This results in 95(103;109;117;123;131)sts.

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll alt row 4(1;0;0;0;0) times

Inc 1 st every foll 4th row 6(9;7;3;2;2) times

Inc 1 st every foll 6th row 0(0;3;7;8;8) times

This results in 115(123;129;137;143;151)sts.

Cont in st st until work measures 19 (19, 19.3, 19.7, 20.1, 20.5) inches from beg ending with a WSR.

#### **SHAPE ARMHOLES:**

Bind off 5(5;6;6;7;7)sts at beg of next 2 rows

Bind off 2 sts at beg of foll 4(6;6;6;8;8) rows

Dec 1 st at each end of every foll alt row 4(4;4;6;5;7) times

This results in 89(93;97;101;103;107)sts.

Cont in st st until work measures 26(26.75, 27.5, 28.25, 29, 30) inches from beg ending with a WSR.

#### **SHAPE SHOULDERS:**

Bind off 8(8;9;9;10;10)sts at beg of next 2 rows

This results in 73(77;79;83;83;87)sts.

Bind off rem sts for back neck.

#### **FRONT:**

Work as for back and work measures 21.5(22, 22.5, 23, 23.25, 23.5) inches from beg ending with a WSR.

#### **SHAPE NECK:**

K36(36;37;39;39;41)sts and move these sts onto a holder

Bind off centre 17(21;23;23;25;25)sts for neck opening

K rem 36(36;37;39;39;41)sts for left side of work.

#### **LEFT SIDE:**

Work one row.

Bind off 7sts at beg (neck edge) of next row

Bind off 6sts at same edge of foll alt row

Bind off 5sts at beg of foll alt row

Bind off 4sts at beg of foll alt row

Bind off 0(0;0;2;2;2)sts at beg of foll alt row

Dec 1 st (K2tog) at beg of every foll 4th row 6(6;6;6;5;7) times

This results in 8(8;9;9;10;10)sts.

Cont in st st until work measures same as back to beg of shoulder shaping ending with a RSR

#### **SHAPE SHOULDER:**

Cast off 8(8;9;9;10;10)sts at beg of next row, fasten off.

#### **RIGHT SIDE:**

WSF, rejoin yarn at neck edge, pick up sts from holder and work as for left side, rev shaping.

#### **SLEEVES (Both Alike):**

Using US 3(3.25mm) needles cast on 63(65;65;69;69;75)sts

Work in st st for 2.35(2.35, 2.35, 2.75, 2.75, 2.75) inches ending with a WSR.

Cont in st st; inc 1 st at each end of every foll 12(10;8;8;8;8)th row 9(7;6;6;20;20) times

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 14(12;10;10;10;10)th row 3(7;11;11;0;0) times

This results in 87(93;99;103;109;115)sts.

Cont in st st until work measures 19.25(19.7, 20.1, 20.5, 20.9, 21.3) inches from beg ending with a WSR,

#### **SHAPE TOP OF SLEEVE:**

Bind off 5(5;6;6;6;7)sts at beg of next 2 rows

Bind off 2sts at beg of foll 4(4;4;4;6;6) rows

Dec 1 st at each end of every foll alt row 14(15;16;17;18;16) times

Dec 1 st at each end of next 12(13;14;15;14;18) rows

This results in 17(19;19;19;21;21)sts.

Bind off rem sts.

### **TO MAKE UP:**

Sew shoulder seams. Set in sleeves. Sew up side and sleeve seams. Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
