# New Kid Seta Lace Scarf

**MATERIALS:** (25g balls) Kid Seta 2 balls Red #16

One pair US Size 6 / 4 mm knitting needles.

## MEASUREMENTS:

78 inches / 200cm (without fringes)

THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE ONE SIZE ONLY.

**TENSION:** SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION.

26sts and 24 rows = 3 inches / 10cm over Eyelet Pattern using US 6 / 4mm needles.

FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION.

IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON TEST SWATCH, USE THINNER NEEDLES;

IF THERE ARE TOO MANY STS, USE THICKER NEEDLES.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**alt** = alternate; **beg** = begin(ning); **cont** = continue; **folll(s)** = follow(s)ing; **k** = knit; **patt(s)** = pattern (s); **p** = purl; **rep** = repeat; **R(W)SF** = right(wrong) side facing; **R(W)SR** = right(wrong) side row; **SKPO** = slip one, knit one, pass slipped stitch over; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **yfd** = yarn forward.

## STICHES USED:

EYELET PATTERN (worked over a multiple of 15sts + 2) as folls:

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** P.

**2<sup>nd</sup> and every alt row:** K.

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** P6, \*k2tog, yfd, k1, yfd, SKPO, p10, rep from \* to last 11sts, k2tog, yfd, k1, yfd, SKPO, p6.

**5<sup>th</sup> row:** P5, \*k2tog, yfd, k3, yfd, SKPO, p8, rep from \* to last 12sts, k2tog, yfd, k3, yfd, SKPO, p5.

**7<sup>th</sup> row:** P4, \*(k2tog, yfd) twice, k1, (yfd, SKPO) twice, p6, rep from \* to last 13sts, (k2tog, yfd) twice, k1, (yfd, SKPO) twice, p4.

**9<sup>th</sup> row:** P3, \*(k2tog, yfd) twice, k3, (yfd, SKPO) twice, p4, rep from \* to last 14sts, (k2tog, yfd) twice, k3, (yfd, SKPO) twice, p3.

**11<sup>th</sup> row:** P2, \*(k2tog, yfd) 3 times, k1, (yfd, SKPO) 3 times, p2, rep from \* to last 15sts, (k2tog, yfd) 3 times, k1, (yfd, SKPO) 3 times, p2.

**13<sup>th</sup> row:** P3, \*(k2tog, yfd) twice, k3, (yfd, SKPO) twice, p4, rep from \* to last 14sts, (k2tog, yfd) twice, k3, (yfd, SKPO) twice, p3.

**15<sup>th</sup> row:** P4, \*(k2tog, yfd) twice, k1, (yfd, SKPO) twice, p6, rep from \* to last 13sts, (k2tog, yfd) twice, k1, (yfd, SKPO) twice, p4.

**17<sup>th</sup> row:** P5, \*k2tog, yfd, k3, yfd, SKPO, p8, rep from \* to last 12sts, k2tog, yfd, k3, yfd, SKPO, p5.

**19<sup>th</sup> row:** P6, \*k2tog, yfd, k1, yfd, SKPO, p10, rep from \* to last 11sts, k2tog, yfd, k1, yfd, SKPO, p6.

**20<sup>th</sup> row:** K.

Rep these 20 rows.

**SCARF:**

Using US 6 / 4mm needles cast on 47sts loosely and work in Eyelet patt (SEE STS USED) and when work measures more or less 78 inches / 200cm from beg ending with a 20<sup>th</sup> row of patt, cast off all sts with a bigger needle.

**TO MAKE UP:**

**FRINGES:** Cut lengths of yarn each 11 inches / 30cm long, fold 3 strands tog in half and draw loops through first st at one end of scarf, draw ends of strands through loop and tighten. Rep this 1cm apart along each end of scarf. Trim ends.
