



Eco Duo Cabled Scarf

Cascade Using Eco Duo Yarn

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A simple, yet beautiful cabled scarf that takes advantage of the natural shadowing of Eco Duo – 1 skein will make a short scarf, 2 will be a generous length for wrapping.

Materials: 1 -2 skeins Cascade Yarns Eco Duo (70% Undyed Baby Alpaca/30% Undyed Merino Wool – 197 yards per 100 g) – shown in 1703
1 set US 9 needles
1 Cable needle (or smaller size double point needle)

Abbreviations: K – Knit
P – Purl
CNF2 – Slip 2 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front, K2; K2 from cable needle
CNB2 – Slip 2 stitches onto cable needle and hold in back, K2; K2 from cable needle

Cast on 40 stitches.

Row 1: K4, P2, CNF2, P4, CNF2, K4, CNB2, P4, CNB2, P2, K4

Row 2 (and all even number rows): K2, P2, K2, P4, K4, P12, K4, P4, K2, P2, K2

Row 3: K4, P2, K4, P4, K2, CNF2, CNB2, K2, P4, K4, P2, K4

Row 4: REPEAT ROW 2

Row 5: K4, P2, K4, P4, K4, CNF2, K4, P4, K4, P2, K4

Row 6: REPEAT ROW 2

Repeat 6 rows until reach desired length, then bind off, and weave in ends.
