# Contemporary Jacket

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## Sizes

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X). Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for other sizes noted in parentheses as necessary.

## Finished Measurements

Bust: 34 (38, 41 ½, 45, 49)"

Total length: 28 (28 ½, 29, 29 ½, 29 ½)"

## Materials

- ◆ Cascade Yarn's *Sierra*, 6 (6, 7, 8) hanks of #44 (A), 1 (2, 2, 2) hanks of #43 (B), and 1 hank of #410 (C)
- ◆ One pair *each* of sizes 5 and 7 knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- ◆ One 1 3/8" button (JHB International's *Style #17634* was used on sample garment)
- ◆ Two stitch holders

## Gauge

In Stockinette St Patt with larger needles, 17 sts and 24 rows = 4". **To save time, take time to check gauge.**

## Stitch Patterns

**Border Pattern** (*mult 10 sts*)

**Row 1 (RS):** With B, \*K2tog, K2, (knit into the front and back of next st) *twice*, K2, SSK. Repeat from \* across.

**Row 2:** With B, knit across.

**Row 3:** With B, same as Row 1.

**Row 4:** With B, knit across.

**Row 5:** With A, same as Row 1.

**Row 6:** With A, purl across.

**Rows 7 and 8:** With C, same as Rows 1 and 2.

**Rows 9 and 10:** With A, same as Rows 5 and 6.

**Rows 11 and 12:** With B, same as rows 1 and 2.

**Stockinette St Pattern**

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit across.

**Row 2:** Purl across.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for patt.

## Note

- ◆ For fully-fashioned single decreases: On RS rows, K2, SSK, work across in patt as established until 4 sts rem, ending row with K2tog, K2; on WS rows, P2, P2tog, work across in patt as established until 4 sts rem in row, ending row with SSP, P2.

## Back

With larger needles and B, CO 90 (100, 110, 120, 130) sts.

Work Border Patt until Row 12 is completed.

Change to larger needles and A, beg Stockinette St Patt, and work fully-fashioned decreases (see Note) each side every twelfth row 1 (0, 0, 0, 0) times, every tenth row 8 (6, 2, 0, 0) times, every eighth row 0 (4, 9, 10, 7) times, then every sixth row 0 (0, 0, 2, 6) times—72 (80, 88, 96, 104) sts rem.

Cont even until piece measures approx 19" from beg, ending after WS row.

#### **Shape Armholes**

BO 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts at beg of next two rows, BO 2 (3, 4, 5, 6) sts at beg of next two rows, then work fully-fashioned decreases (see Note) each side every other row 0 (1, 2, 3, 5) times, then every fourth row 3 (3, 3, 3, 2) times—54 (56, 58, 60, 62) sts rem.

Cont even in patt until piece measures approx 27 (27 ½, 28, 28 ½, 28 ½)" from beg, ending after WS row.

#### **Shape Shoulders**

BO 4 (5, 5, 5, 6) at beg of next four rows, then BO 5 (4, 5, 6, 5) sts at beg of next two rows—28 sts rem.

BO.

## **Pocket Linings** *(make two)*

With larger needles and A, CO 22 sts.

Beg Stockinette St Patt, and work even until piece measures approx 5" from beg, ending after RS row. Slip sts onto holder.

## **Left Front**

With larger needles and B, CO 40 (50, 50, 60, 60) sts.

Work Border Patt until Row 12 is completed.

Change to larger needles and A, beg Stockinette St Patt, and work fully-fashioned decreases (see Note) at armhole edge every twelfth row 1 (0, 1, 0, 0) times, every tenth row 8 (0, 8, 0, 2) times, every eighth row 0 (7, 0, 1, 9) times, then every sixth row 0 (6, 0, 14, 0) times, **and at the same time**, when piece measures approx 8" from beg, ending after RS row, Place Pocket Linings on WS row as follows: Work across first 8 sts, slip next 22 sts onto holder, work across 22 sts from one pocket lining holder, work to end row.

Cont even on 31 (37, 41, 45, 49) sts until piece measures approx 19" from beg, ending after WS row.

#### **Shape Armhole**

BO 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts at armhole edge once, BO 2 (3, 4, 5, 6) sts at armhole edge once, then work fully-fashioned decreases (see Note) at armhole edge every other row 0 (1, 2, 3, 5) times, then every fourth row 3 (3, 3, 3, 2) times—22 (25, 26, 27, 28) sts rem.

Cont even in patt until piece measures approx 25 (25 ½, 26, 26 ½, 26 ½)" from beg, ending after RS row.

#### **Shape Neck**

BO 4 (6, 6, 6, 6) sts at neck edge once, BO 2 sts at neck edge once, then dec 1 st at neck edge every row three times—13 (14, 15, 16, 17) sts rem.

Cont even until piece measures same as back to shoulders, ending after WS row.

#### **Shape Shoulders**

BO 4 (5, 5, 5, 6) at shoulder edge twice.

Work one row even.

BO rem 5 (4, 5, 6, 5) sts.

## Right Front

Same as left front *except* reverse all shaping.

## Sleeves

With larger needles and B, CO 70 sts.

Beg Border Patt, and work even until Row 12 is completed.

Change to larger needles, A, and Stockinette St, and work fully-fashioned decreases (see Note) each side every sixth row 5 (1, 0, 0, 0) times, every eighth row 1 (4, 1, 0, 0) times, every tenth row 0 (0, 2, 0, 0) times, every twelfth row 0 (0, 0, 2, 0) times, every fourteenth row 0 (0, 0, 1, 2) times—58 (60, 62, 64, 66) sts rem.

Cont even until sleeve measures approx 9" from beg, ending after WS row.

BO 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts at beg of next two rows, then work fully-fashioned decreases (see Note) each side every fourth row 1 (3, 4, 6, 6) times, then every other row 12 (10, 9, 7, 7) times—24 sts.

Work 1 (0, 1, 0, 0) row even.

BO 3 sts at beg of next four rows—12 sts rem.

BO.

## Finishing

Block pieces to measurements.

Sew shoulder seams.

### Buttonband

With RS facing, smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 99 (102, 105, 108, 108) sts along left front.

Beg Garter St Patt, and work even until band measures approx 1 ½" from beg.

BO.

Place marker for one button approx ¼" down from beg of front neck shaping.

### Buttonhole Band

Same as buttonband along right front until band measures approx ¾" from beg.

**Next Row:** Make buttonhole opposite markers by binding off 4 sts.

**Next Row:** CO4 sts over the bound-off sts of previous row.

Cont even until band measures approx 1 ½" from beg.

BO.

### Pocket Edgings

With RS facing, smaller needles, and B, pick up and K sts from pocket holder.

Knit one row with B.

Knit 2 rows with A, knit 2 rows with C, knit 2 rows with A, then knit one row with B.

BO with B.

Sew linings to WS of fronts. Sew sides of pocket edgings to RS of front.

### **Collar**

With smaller needles and B, CO 80 sts.

Beg Border Patt, and work even until Row 12 is completed.

Change to larger needles, and repeat Rows 5 and 6 with A until collar measures approx 5" from beg, ending after WS row.


BO.

With WS facing, sew collar into place.


Set in sleeves.

Sew side and sleeve seams.


Sew on button.
