# Sierra Cats Meow Pullover

Size 2 (4,6)

## Materials:

Sierra—80% pima cotton 20% merino wool 191 yards 100 grams

3 ( 4, 5) skeins periwinkle color 22 A

1 (2, 2) skeins jade color 13 B

1 skein hot pink color 17 C

1 skein winter white color 03 D

US Size 5 and 7 needles

US Size 7 double pointed needles

thin tubular black elastic

embroidery needle

Gauge: 20 sts and 26 rows = 4"

Stripe pattern : wk in St st \*4 rows B, 4 rows A; repeat from \* ( 8 rows)

## Knitted measurements:

chest- 26 (28, 31)"

body length - 15 1/4 (16 1/4, 17 1/4)" unrolled

sleeve length - 13 (13 1/2, 14)" unrolled

armhole depth - 5 3/4 ( 6 1/4, 6 3/4)"

## Back:

With larger needles and A, cast on 64 ( 70, 78)sts. Work in St st until piece measures 15 1/4 ( 16 1/4, 17 1/4)" from beg. On WS

bind off 19 (21, 25) sts for shoulder, wk across 26 (28, 28) sts and place on holder. Bind off remaining 19 (21, 25) sts for shoulder.

## Front:

With larger needles and A, cast on 64 (70, 78) sts. Work in St st until piece measures 4 1/2 (5 1/2, 6 1/2)" from beg. On RS with A,

wk 18 (21, 25) sts. Join B and wk 27 st chart pattern #1, end 19 (22, 26) sts. Continue in this manner until 45 row chart is complete.

(remember to wk 2 rows between MEOW and cat). Continue in A until piece measures 12 3/4 (13 3/4, 14 3/4)" from beg.

neck shaping: On RS, knit 26 (29, 33)sts, join second ball of yarn and bind off center 12 sts; wk to end. Wk both sides at once, bind off 2 sts twice, and 1 st three times at neck edge. Wk even until piece measures 15 1/4 (16 1/4, 17 1/4)" from beg. Bind off remaining 19 (21, 25)sts for each shoulder.

## Sleeves:

With larger needles and A, cast on 34 sts. Wk in St st for 1 1/2" Join B and continue in stripe pattern for

entire sleeve. AT SAME TIME:

increase 1 st at each side every 6th row until 58 (62, 66)sts are reached. Wk even until piece measures 13 (13 1/2, 14)" from beg. Bind off on WS.

Finishing:

Block pieces to measurements. Sew left shoulder seam.

neckband: With RS facing, with smaller needles and A, pick up 72 (74, 74) sts along neckline. Wk in k1 p1 rib for 1". On RS wk in St st for 1". Bind off on RS.

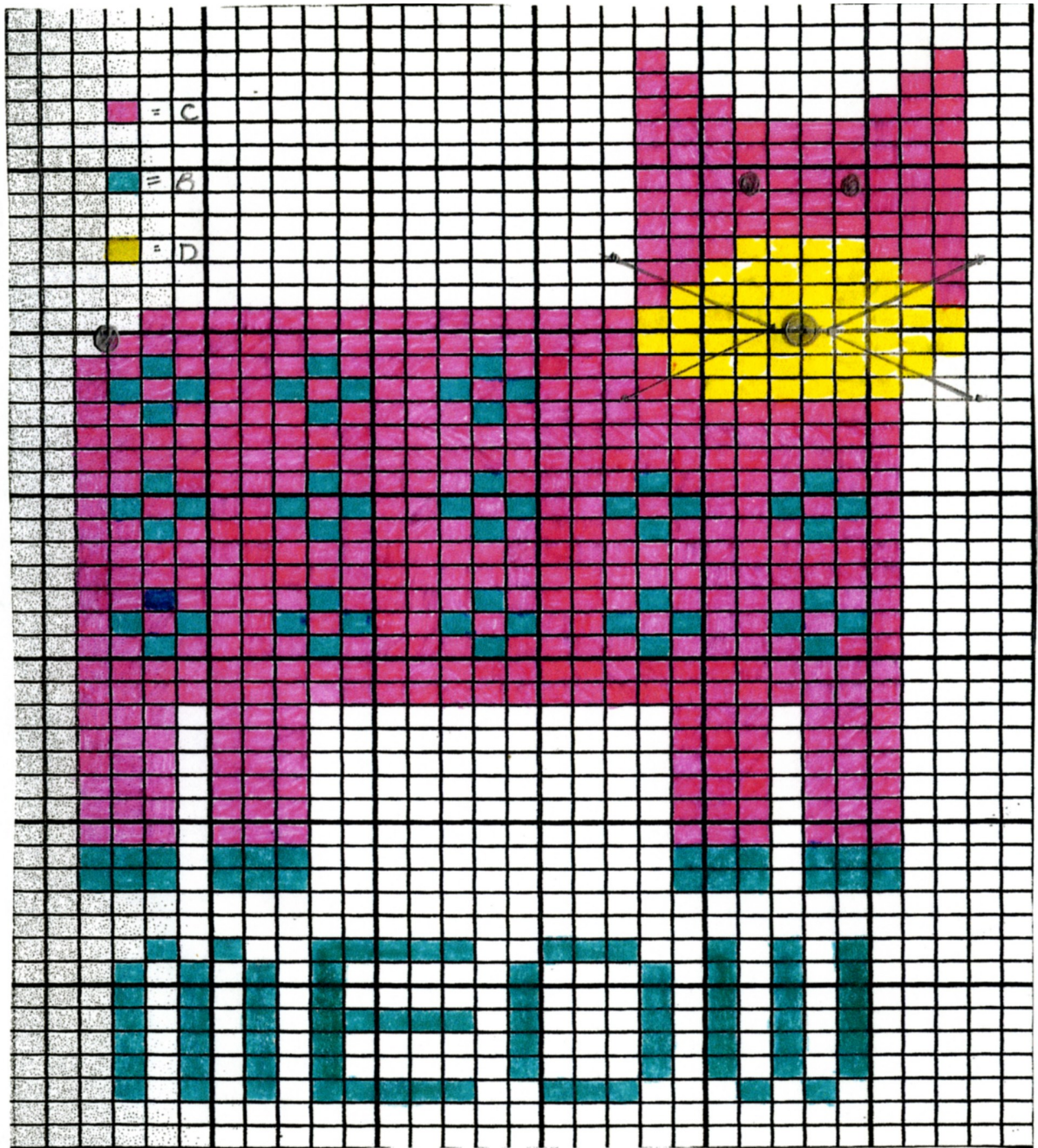
Sew second shoulder and neckband seam. Mark 5 3/4(6 1/4, 6 3/4)" down from shoulder at each armhole edge. Sew top of sleeve at armhole edge between markers. Sew remaining side and sleeve seams.

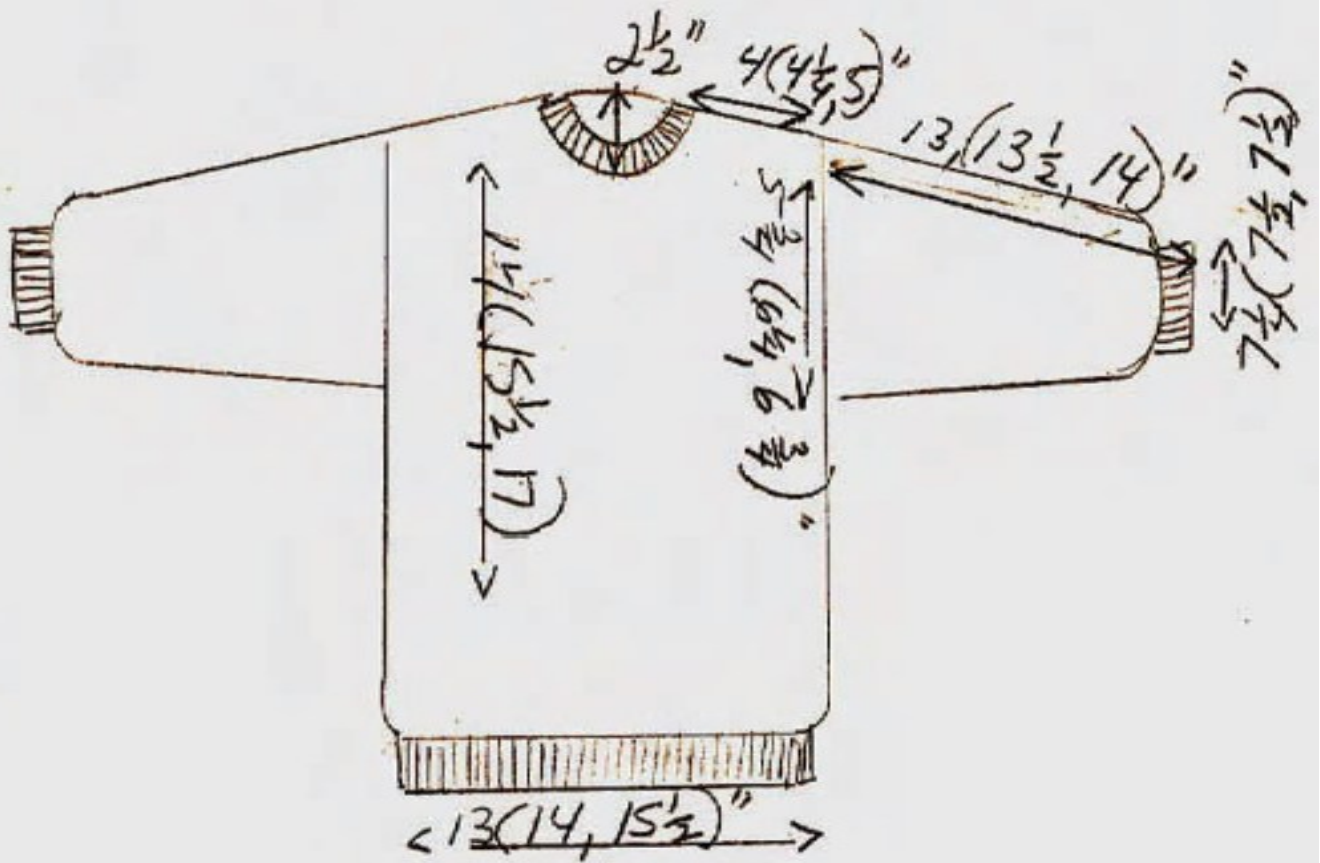
Tail: With double pointed needles and C, cast on 4 sts. Wk i-cord for 7 1/2", cut yarn and pull tight through remaining sts. Swirl tail as indicated on picture. With strand of C, tack down underneath tail in a swirl.

Eyes: with strand of B, form french knots as indicated on chart.

Nose: with strand of C, form french knot as indicated on chart.

Whiskers: cut 2 4 1/2" strands of black elastic , attach as indicated on chart. Fold each piece in half, pull through and knot ends. With white thread secure each whisker at insertion.
