Materials: Cascade Yarn's Cash Vero DK 55% Merino extra fine wool, 33% microfiber,
12% cashmere: 1 skein MC #01, 1 skein CC #28
Size 6 needles
Yarn needle

Gauge: 5 ½ sts = 1" in st st

Abbreviations: St st = Stockinette stitch
K2 tog =knit 2 together

Size: Size 2-3 child's (17"-18" around)

Ribbing:

Row 1: K1, *K2, P1* rep between *'s end K1.

Row 2: K1, *K1, P2* rep between *'s end K1.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for pattern.

With CC, cast on 98 sts and work 2 rows in ribbing above.

Change to MC and work 6 rows in ribbing as established.

Work 2 rows in st st, knitting 1st and last stitch on every row.

Change to CC and continuing in st st begin working chart. Continue to knit the 1st and last st on every row.

Work 6 rows in MC in st st, decreasing 8 sts on last row to 90 sts.

Crown:

Row 1: *K8, K2tog* rep between *'s across.

Row 2: and all even rows, K1, P to last st, K1.

Row 3: *K7, K2tog* rep between *'s across.

Row 5: *K6, K2tog* rep between *'s across.

Row 7: *K5, K2tog* rep between *'s across.

Row 9: *K4, K2tog* rep between *'s across.

Change to CC:

Row 11: *K3, K2tog* rep between *'s across.

Row 12: same as row 2 in CC.

Change to MC;

Row 13: *K2, K2tog* rep between *'s across.

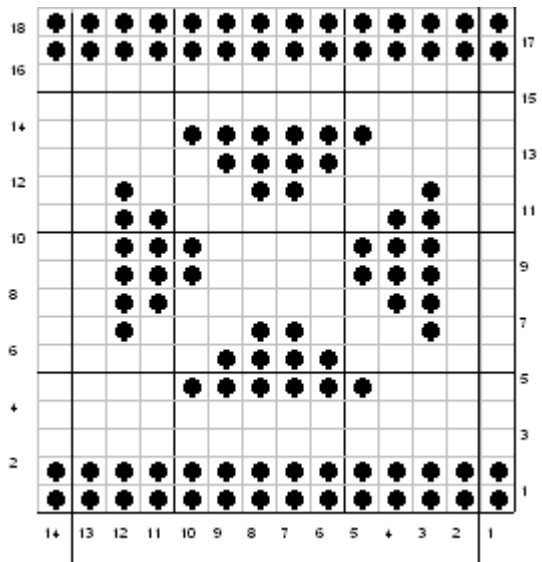
Row 14: same as row 2 in MC.

Change to CC:

Row 15: *K1, K2tog* rep between *'s across.

Row 17: K2tog across. (9 sts)

Break yarn leaving enough to run through remaining sts and sew back seam. Weave in all ends.



Repeat section
(stitches 2-13)
