## Cascade Luna and Luna Paints Mat

# Luna and Luna Paints Mat

**Materials:** 3 skeins of Cascade Luna, 100% Peruvian Cotton, 82 yds, 50 g, color #737 (MC) and 2 skeins of Cascade Luna Paints, 100% Peruvian Cotton, 164 yds, 100g, color #9832 (CC),

**Needle Size :** US # 7/4.5 mm needle, circular is preferable to hold all the sts.  
Large crochet hook, around H8/5.0 mm, but size is not critical.

**Directions:**

Using MC cast on 144 sts. \*K2 rows in MC, k2 rows in CC. Repeat from \* until mat measures 14" from cast on edge.

End having knit K2 rows in MC and bind off all sts.

To make fringe cut equal sized lengths of the CC yarn, sample shown uses 12" pieces.

Hold 4 of these pieces together and fold in half. With the wrong side of the mat facing up push the crochet hook through the edge of the mat.

Pull all 4 pieces of yarn through the edge of the smaller side of the mat, so that there is a loop at the midpoint of the pieces of yarn.

Pull the ends of the yarn through the loop, and pull tight. You should have a fringe with a band around the top of the yarn visible on the right side of the mat.

Repeat this process placing one fringe every three CC stripes.

Put fringe on both of the shorter sides of your mat.
