

Chickadee Shrug

by Tanis Gray for Cascade Yarns

Materials:

- 2 Skeins Cascade Yarns *Pacific Chunky* (3.5oz/100g ea approx. 120yds/110m, 60% acrylic, 40% superwash merino wool) in #51 pink

****NOTE*** If you wish to add reps to make finished shrug wider, 1 additional skein of yarn will be needed!*

- Size US 10 24" Circular Knitting Needle
- Tapestry Needle

Approximate Finished Size:

- 17 x 26"

Gauge:

- 17 sts and 16 rows / 4" in lace pattern

Lace Pattern:

- Row 1: k1, *p2, k3, k2tog, yo* to last 3 sts, p2, k1
- Row 2: k3, *[k1, p1, k1, p1] into yo, p4, k2* k1
- Row 3: k1, *p2, k2, k2tog, k4* to last 3 sts, p2, k1
- Row 4: k3, *p7, k2* k1
- Row 5: k1, *p2, k1, k2tog, k4* to last 3 sts, p2, k1
- Row 6: k3, *p6, k2* k1
- Row 7: k1, *p2, k2tog, k4* to last 3 sts, p2, k1
- Row 8: k3, *p5, k2* k1

Instructions:

- CO 60 sts, leaving 15" tail, do not join into round
- Work *k2, p2* for 10 rows
- Begin lace chart and work for 10 reps total

****NOTE*** If you wish to add reps to make finished shrug wider, 1 additional skein of yarn will be needed!*

- Work *k2, p2* for 10 rows
- BO in rib, leaving 15" tail
- Block



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Finishing

- Using 15" tail, mattress st edges together for 5" to form sleeve, repeat for opposite side
- Weave in all loose ends with tapestry needle
