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Sizes:2 (4,6)

Knitted measurements:

chest - 26 (28, 31)"

body length 14 (15 1/2, 17)"

sleeve length 11 1/2(12, 12 1/2)"

armhole depth 5 3/4(6 1/3, 6 3/4)"

Materials: 220 Superwash®

100% superwash wool 220 yards 100 grams 2(3, 4) skeins periwinkle color 845 "A"

1 skein acid green color 802 "B"

1 skein yellow color 820 "C"

1 skein turquoise color 846 "D"

1 skein orange color 822 "E"

size 5 and 7 needles

size G/6 crochet hook

embroidery needle

5 green 4 hole button - 1/2"

Gauge: 20sts and 26 rows = 4"

stripe pattern: 2 rows B in garter, 2 rows A in St st, 2 rows E in garter, 2 rows A in St st, 2 rows D in garter st.

Back:

With smaller needles and A cast on 64 (70, 78)sts. Wk in k1 p1 rib for 8 rows. Change to larger needles and continue in St st for 2 rows; wk stripe pattern once. Wk 2 rows A in St st. On RS join B and wk 2 rows. Wk 12 (15,17) sts B, *join E and wk 15 st chart pattern #3 (reversed) , wk 10 (10, 14)sts B. Repeat from *(not reversed), end 12 (15, 17)sts B. AT SAME TIME: Wk 12 rows B, wk 12 rows D for background charts. Wk 2 rows D. Wk 2 rows A, Wk stripe pattern once.

When complete, continue in A in St st until piece measures 14(15 1/2, 17)" from beg. On WS bind off 19 (21, 25) sts for shoulder, wk across 26 (28, 28)sts and place on holder, bind off remaining sts for shoulder.

Left Front:

With smaller needles and A cast on 30(33, 37)sts. Wk in k1 p1 rib for 8 rows. Change to larger needles continue in St st for 2 rows; wk stripe pattern once. Wk 2 rows A in St st. On RS join B and wk 2 rows. Wk 7(9, 11) sts B, join E and wk 15 st chart #3, end 8(9, 11)sts .

AT SAME TIME:

Wk 12 rows B, wk 12 rows D for background charts. Wk 2 rows A. Wk stripe pattern once. When complete, continue in A in St st until piece measures 11 1/2 (13, 14 1/2)" from beg.

Neck shaping: On RS bind off 4 sts. Continue to bind off at neck edge 2 sts twice, (3 times, 3 times) and one stitch at neck edge 3 times (twice, twice). Wk even until piece measures 14(15 1/2. 17)" from beg. Bind off remaining 19(21, 25) sts for shoulder.

Right Front:

Follow instructions for left front, reverse chart and neck shaping.

Sleeves:

With smaller needles and A cast on 34 (36, 36) sts. Wk in k1 p1 rib for 8 rows. Change to larger needles continue in St st for 2 rows; increase 4 sts evenly across row #1 - 38 (40, 40)sts. Wk stripe pattern once, continue in A. **AT SAME TIME:** increase 1 st at each side every 6th row until 58 (64, 66) sts are reached. Wk even until piece measures 11 1/2 (12, 12 1/2)" from beg. Bind Off.

Finishing:

Block pieces to measurements. Sew shoulders. Mark 5 3/4 (6 1/4, 6 1/2)" down from shoulder at each armhole edge. Sew top of sleeve at armhole edge between markers.

Sew remaining side and sleeve seams.

Neckband: With RS facing, with smaller needles and A, pick up and k 64 (68, 70)sts evenly around neck. Wk in k1 p1 rib for 7 rows. Bind off in rib. Buttonhole band (left front): With RS facing, with smaller needles and A, pick up 72(78, 84) sts evenly down center front edge. Wk in k1p1 rib for 3 rows.

To form buttonholes:

on WS wk 5(4, 5)sts in rib.* Bind off 2 sts in rib, wk 13 (15,16)sts in rib; repeat *4 times, end with 5 (4,5) sts in rib. On RS continue in rib, wk 5 (4,5) sts,* cast on 2 sts over bound off sts, 13 (15, 16)sts in between ; repeat *4 times, end 5(4,5)sts in rib. Wk 2 rows rib.(7 rows total) Bind off in rib.


Button band (right front): With RS facing, with smaller needles and A, pick up 72 (78,84) sts evenly down center front edge. Wk in k1 p1 rib for 7 rows. Bind off in rib. Sew buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

Eyes: With strand of D, form french knots as indicated on chart.

Bows: With A and crochet hook chain 14 sts , form circle and wrap strand around center.

Attach as indicated on chart. Bind off.


