Cable Lover's Pullover



Ecological Wool® Cable Lovers Pullover

Materials: Ecological Wool, 4 skeins of #8018

Needles size: 7 straight & double pointed, size 9 straight, stitch markers, cable needle

Gauge: 4 st = 1" in st st on #9's

Finished Sizes: L and XL

Measurements at underarm: 40", 44", sleeve length: 17 ½", 18"

Abbreviations: C4B: (Cable 4 back.) Sl 2 sts on cable needle and hold in back of work, K next two sts, K2 from cable needle.

C4F (Cable 4 front) Sl 2 sts on cable needle and hold in front of work, K next two sts, K 2 sts from cable needle.

PM: Place Marker

Cn: Cable needle

T2/4: sl 2 sts to cn and hold in back, K4 from left needle, K2 from cn.

T4/2: Sl 4 sts to cn and hold in front, K2 from left needle, K4 from cn.

C8F: Sl 4 sts to cn and hold in front, K4 from left needle, K4 from cn.

C10B: Sl next 5 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 5 sts from left-handed needle, then knit sts from cable needle.

C10F: Sl next 5 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, knit next 5 sts from left-handed needle, then knit sts from cable needle.

Rstst: Reverse stockinette stitch. Knit one row, purl one row, purl is on the right side.

Ribbing Pattern

Row 1: K2, *P2, K4, P2, K2* rep from * to end.

Row 2 and all even rows: K on the K's and P on the P's as they face you.

Row 3: K2, *P2, C4B, P2, K2* rep from * to end.

Row 4: As row 2.

Repeat these 4 rows for pattern.

Pattern #1 One/One Cable

Row 1: Sl 1 st onto cable needle and hold in back, Knit next st, K st from cable needle.

Row 2: Purl 2.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

Pattern #2 Splitting Cable (20 sts)

Row 1: (right side) K20.

Row 2: P20

Row 3: C10B, C10F.

Row 4: P20.

Rows 5-18: rep 1st and 2nd rows 7 times.

Repeat these 18 rows.

Pattern #3: Center Panel (36 sts)

Row 1: (right side) (p2, K4) 2 times, P2, K8. P2, (K4, P2) 2 times.

Row 2: (K2, P4) 2 times, K2, P8, (K2, P4) 2 times, K2.

Row 3: P2, K4, P2, C4F, P2, C8F, P2, C4B, P2, K4, P2.

Row 4: Same as 2nd row.

Rows 5: (P2, K4) 2 times, T2/4, T4/2, K4, P2, K4, P2.

Row 6: K2, P4, K2, P9, K2, P9, K2, P4, K2.

Row 7: P2, K4, P2, C8B, K1, P2, K1, C8F, P2, K4, P2.

Row 8: (K2, P4) 2 times, (K2, P3) 2 times, (K2, P4) 2 times, K2.

Row 9: P2, K4, T2/4, (P2, K3) 2 times, P2, T4/2, K4, P2.

Row 10: K2, P10, (K2, P3) 2 times, K2, P10, K2.

Row 11: P2, C8B, K2, (P2, K3) 2 times, P2, K2, C8F, P2.

Row 12: K2, (P4, K2) 2 times, (P3, K2) 2 times, (P4, K2) 2 times.

Row 13: P2, K4, P2, C4F, (P2, K3) 2 times, P2, C4B, P2, K4, P2.

Row 14: As row 12.

Row 15: P2, (K4, P2) 2 times, (K3, P2) 2 times, (K4, P2) 2 times.

Row 16: As Row 12.

Row 17: P2, K4, P2, C4F, P2, C8F, P2, C4B, P2, K4, P2.

Row 18: (K2, P4) 2 times, K2, P8, (K2, P4) 2 times, K2.

Row 19: (P2, K4) 2 times, P2, K8, (P2, K4) 2 times, P2.

Row 20: Same as Row 18.

Row 21: P2, K4, P2, C4F, P2, K8, P2, C4B, P2, K4, P2.

Row 22: Same as Row 18.

Repeat these 22rows.

BACK

With size 7 needles cast on 112, 122 sts.

Work in ribbing pattern for 4" Inc to 114, 122 sts on last wrong side row. Change to size 9 needles.

Work 1st rows of patterns in sequence as follows: (P2, K2) once (twice), P2, (side border) PM, 2 sts in Pat #1, PM, P4 (Rstst), PM, 20 STS Pat #2, PM, P4 (Rstst), PM, 2 sts Pat #1, PM, P1 (Rstst), PM, 36 sts in Pat #3 (center panel), PM, P1 (Rstst), PM, 2 sts in Pat 1, PM, P4, (Rstst), PM, 20 sts in pat #2, PM, P4 (Rstst), PM, 2 sts in pat #1, PM, (P2, K2) once (twice), P2 (side border) Work the side border stitches as they face you on following rows.

Work in patterns as described until 27" from the beginning.

Next Row: Work across to center 37 sts. Bind off center 37 sts, work to end. Work both sides of neck at once, adding a ball of yarn to other side. Decrease one st at neck edge every other row twice. Work one row. Bind off.

FRONT

Work as for back until piece measures 23". Work across to center 26 sts, bind off center 26 sts, work to end. Attach another ball and working both sides at the same time, decrease one st at neck edge every other row 8 times. Work to measure same as back. Bind off.

SLEEVES

With size 7 needles, cast on 42, 52 sts.

Work in ribbing as for back for 3 1/2" increasing to 52, 58 sts on last wrong side row. Change to size 9 needle and establish patterns as follows:

K4 (7), pm, pat #1 on 2 sts, pm, P2 (Rstst), pm, pat #3 center panel 36 sts, pm, P2 (Rstst), PM, pat #1 on 2 sts, PM, K4 (7) sts. Work in patterns as established increasing one st each end every 3/4" to 86 (94) sts, working new sts in to pat as described for back.

Work to measure 17 ½", 18" from beg or desired length to armhole. Bind off.

COLLAR

Sew shoulder seams and using size 7 dbl pointed needles with right side facing, pick up and knit 110 sts evenly around neck edge. Work in rib pat as given above between *'s. Work for 1 ½" and bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Sew in sleeves. Sew side seams. Weave in all ends.
